Approximately 6,307 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

#### **Scope and Content**

The materials in FOIA 2017-0231-F are a selective body responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material.

FOIA request 2017-0231-F contains photographs from the White House Photograph Office (WHPO) relating to the Israeli and Palestinian peace process during the Clinton Administration. Included are materials relating to arrivals & departures, meetings prior to and following events, speaking engagements including ceremonies and press briefings, signing ceremonies relating to the topic, and conferring with senior administration officials.

Materials range from July 9, 1996, which was Prime Minister Netanyahu's visit to the White House, October 1 through 2, 1996, during a peace summit in Washington, DC, December 14, 1998, during a trip to Gaza City, Gaza, July 15 through 16, 1999 and July 18 through 19, 1999, which encompasses Prime Minister Ehud Barak's visit to Camp David and the White House, January 3 through 10, 2000, and

during the Shepherdstown peace talks, which were meetings regarding the upcoming Camp David Peace Summit, and December 19, 2000, which was a meeting with President-elect George W. Bush.

Key individuals in the photographs include President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Vice President Albert "Al" Gore Jr., Prime Minister Binyamin (Benjamin) Netanyahu of Israel, Prime Minister Ehud Barak of Israel, Chairman Yasser Arafat of the Palestinian Liberation Organization (PLO), and King Hussein of Jordan.
