Approximately 2,311 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

#### **Access**

#### **Scope and Content**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 15) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from February 15, 1994, through February 21, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.
