Extent

Approximately 2,415 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Access

Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 21) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment were created from March 8, 1994 through March 11, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff and others for the time period processed. Noteworthy is Lloyd Cutler replacing Bernard Nussbaum, meetings regarding Health Care, and greeting astronauts that repaired the Hubble Telescope.

Photographs from March 8, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Representative Wilbert Joseph Tauzin and Representative Blanche Lambert in separate meetings in the Oval Office of the White House. Also present is Pat Griffin.

President William Jefferson Clinton walks with Alexis Herman at the White House after his return from the Washington Convention Center.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets Lloyd Cutler and his staff in the Oval Office of the White House. Also present is artist Polly Kraft (wife of Lloyd Cutler). The President participates in a briefing prior to the announcement of Cutler as interim White House Counsel. Present include Vice President Al Gore, Jr., Paul Begala, Mandy Grunwald, David Gergen, Joel Klein, Dee Dee Myers. The President converses with Ricki Seidman and Nancy Hernreich outside the Oval Office. The President and Lloyd Cutler proceed to an event announcing Cutler as interim White House Counsel to replace Bernard Nussbaum. Photographed include Thomas "Mack" McLarty, George Stephanopoulos, Harold Ickes, Andrew Friendly, Bruce Lindsey, Phil Lader, David Gergen, and Jeremy Gains, among others. Photographed among the press include Andrea Mitchell, Rita Braver, and Brit Hume.

President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Vice President Al Gore, Jr., deliver remarks during a staff meeting in the East Room of the White House. Present also are Lloyd Cutler and Polly Kraft (wife of Lloyd Cutler).

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton speaks with Melanne Verveer and Lisa Caputo at the White House.

Thomas "Mack" McLarty greets business executives in his office in the West Wing of the White House.

Photographs from March 9, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton goes on his morning jog. The President proceeds to Memorial Bridge to Arlington National Cemetery.

President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Al Gore, Jr., meet with Senator Ted Kennedy and Senator George Mitchell in the Oval Office of the White House. Also present include Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Pat Griffin, and George Stephanopoulos.

President William Jefferson Clinton announces the Earned Income Tax Credit in the Oval Office of the White House. Present include Vice President Al Gore, Jr., Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Internal Revenue Service Commissioner Margaret "Peggy" Richardson, Secretary of Health & Human Services Donna Shalala, Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown, Roger Altman, and Erskine Bowles, among others. Prior to the announcement the President participates in a meeting. President William Jefferson Clinton addresses the Re-Employment Act event in the East Room of the White House. Present include Vice President Al Gore, Jr., Secretary of Labor Robert Reich, Lane Kirkland, and John Hahn, among others. Also photographed included Reverend Jesse Jackson, Jonathan Prince, Gene Sperling, David Kusnet, Susan Brophy, Sarah Ryan, Ann McCoy, and Carolyn Staley.

President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Al Gore, Jr., meet with members of the Greek-American community. Also photographed is George Stephanopoulos.

President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Al Gore, Jr., meet with a delegation from Ukraine in the Roosevelt Room of the White House.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a meeting regarding health care on Capitol Hill. Present includes Senator Tom Daschle, Senator Christopher Dodd, Senator Harris Wofford, Senator Patrick Leahy, Senator Barbara Boxer, Senator David Pryor, Senator Patty Murray, and Senator Ted Kennedy, among others. The First Lady participates in a photo-op with Senate pages.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Representative Phil Sharp, Senator Carol Moseley-Braun, and Senator Dave Durenberger in separate meetings in the West Wing of the White House. Also photographed is legislative assistant Francesca Cook and senior legislative health care staffer Susan Foote.

Photographs from March 10, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Al Gore, Jr., greet crew of STS-61, the space shuttle mission that repaired the Hubble Telescope. Present include Richard Covey, Kenneth Bowersox, Kathryn Thornton, Claude Nicollier, Jeffrey Hoffman, and Franklin Musgrave. The President is presented with commemorative items that flew on the shuttle mission.

President William Jefferson Clinton disembarks Air Force One at John F. Kennedy International Airport in New York City, New York. Photographed includes Representative Charles Schumer, Attorney General Oliver Koppell, Public Advocate Mark Green, Speaker of the City Council Peter Vallone, Paul Carey, and Flo McAfee, among others. The President proceeds to the 61st Police Precinct in Brooklyn, New York. The President converses with police officers present.

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses an AmeriCorps Public Safety Forum at Brooklyn College in New York City, New York. Present on the dais and participating in the event includes Vernon Lattin, Eli Segal, Matthew Rodriguez, Andy Mills, Geoffrey Canada, Frankie Rios, Kevin Stansberry, Clementine Barfield, Elizabeth Matthews, Molly Baldwin, and Sherman Spears, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Mayor Rudolph Giuliani at the Sheraton New York Hotel. Following the meeting the President greets individuals present at the hotel, including former Mayor David Dinkins & Donald Trump. The President proceeds to a reception for the United Negro College Fund. Present includes August A. Busch, III, William H. Gray, III, Vince Sanders, Pearlina Cox, Stephen Wright, Arthur Fletcher, Vernon Jordan, Christopher Edley, and Alexis Herman. Following the reception, the President proceeds to John F. Kennedy International Airport for departure via Air Force One. Photographed includes Vernon Jordan, Marcia Hale, Carter Wilkie, Jeff Eller, Paul Carey, Flo McAfee, Alexis Herman, and Ben Johnson, among others.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attends the House Health Care message meeting at the United States Capitol in Room H-324. Photographed includes Representative Richard Gephardt & Representative Steny Hoyer, among others. Following the meeting the First Lady returns to the White House. The First Lady greets Shelia Bronfman. Also photographed are Melanne Verveer and Kelly Craighead. The First Lady meets with Senator Herb Kohl in the West Wing.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with members of the United Methodist Church at the White House. Present includes Reverend Thomas Fassett and Bishop Joseph H. Yeakel.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton and Secretary of Education Richard Riley participate in a ceremony for Math & Science teaching awards in the East Room of the White House.

Photographs from March 11, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Al Gore, Jr., participate in a foreign policy meeting. Present include Secretary of Defense William Perry, Thomas “Mack” McLarty, Strobe Talbott, and Tony Lake.

President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Al Gore, Jr., greet a group of students in the Indian Treaty Room. The President and Vice President proceed to the Old Executive Office Building. Photographed includes Thomas “Mack” McLarty, Maggie Williams, Sheila Bronfman, and Richard Bronfman. System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
