Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 68) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken July 11, 1994, through July 12, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Photographs from July 11, 1994, are as follows:

President Clinton meets with German Chancellor Helmut Kohl in the Chancellery in Bonn, Germany. Secretary of State Warren Christopher meets with German government officials in the Chancellery.

President Clinton walks on the grounds of Villa Hammerschmidt with German President Roman Herzog and Chancellor Helmut Kohl. President Clinton and Chancellor Kohl participate in a press statement on the grounds.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participate in an arrival ceremony at the Villa Hammerschmidt with President Roman Herzog and Christine Herzog.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visit Chancellor and Helmut Kohl and Hannelore Kohl at their residence in Ludwigshafen, Germany.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive via Marine One at the Worms Landing Zone for a visit to the U.S. Embassy in Bonn. The Clintons greet U.S. Embassy personnel. President Clinton addresses a group at the U.S. Embassy. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton pose for group photos with the U.S. Marine detachment at the U.S. Embassy.

President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, Chancellor Helmut Kohl, and Hannelore Kohl greet guests at the Petersburg Guest House in Bonn.

President Clinton meets with Secretary Warren Christopher, Mark Gearan, and others at the Petersburg Guest House in Bonn.

Chelsea Clinton tours sights in Bonn with Dorothy Rodham, Capricia Marshall, Julie Hopper, and others.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Chelsea Clinton, and Dorothy Rodham tour the Beethoven Haus in Bonn. Ursula Kinkel, Countess Josephine Posadowsky-Wehner, Barbara Stabreit, and Karin Seeman accompanies them. Margit Ruga conducts the Beethoven Haus tour.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives and tours the Museum of Contemporary History in Bonn. The First Lady is accompanied by Hannelore Kohl and Dr. Herman Scafer, Director of the Museum of Contemporary History.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets people outside the Marriott Hotel in Bonn.

Photographs from July 11, 1994, Continued:

President Clinton and German Political Party Leaders including Rudolf Schauping, Social Democratic Party Chairman, Hans Ulrich Kose, and Klaus Kinkel brief the press at the Petersburg Guest House in Bonn.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton board Marine One at Worms Landing Zone in Bonn. They depart Bonn and travel to Ramstein Air Force Base in Germany.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive at Ramstein Air Force Base. After their disembarking they greet General Robert Oaks, C-130 crew members, and others at the base. President Clinton addresses Air Force personnel and their families. President Clinton joins the Air Force Band at the base event and plays the saxophone with the band.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive at Berlin Airport in Germany.

President Clinton and Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive at the Hotel Intercontinental in Berlin. The Clintons greet hotel personnel.

Photographs from July 12, 1994, are as follows:

President Clinton and Hillary Rodham Clinton greet people at the Hotel Intercontinental in Berlin.

President Clinton goes jogging with U.S. Army personnel in Berlin.

President Clinton arrives at the Reichstag in Berlin. Bundestag President Rita Suesmuth meet the President. Chancellor Helmut Kohl and European President Jacques Delors join them. President Clinton signs the Golden Book in the East Hall.

President Clinton works on his Brandenburg Gate speech at the Reichstag.

President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Chancellor Helmut Kohl, and Hannelore Kohl walks from the Reichstag through the Brandenburg Gate into the Pariser Platz in Berlin. Berlin Mayor Eberhard Diepgen and Monika Diepgen greet them. President Clinton addresses the crowd in the plaza. Chancellor Kohl poses for a photo with Mort Engelberg, and Ambassador Richard Holbrooke following the President Clinton's speech. Views of the large crowd attending the event in the plaza.

Photographs from July 12, 1994, Continued:

President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Chancellor Helmut Kohl, and Hannelore Kohl visit the Neue Synagogue on Oranienburger Strasse. Konstatin Muenz, Director of the Reconstruction Project and Herman Simon, Director of the Community Center conduct the tour for the Clintons and the Kohls. Members of the Jewish Community present small rose windows made of glass from the synagogue's rose window to President Clinton and Chancellor Kohl. The Clintons and the Kohls look at artifacts from the original structure.

President Clinton and Chancellor Helmut Kohl arrive at the Berlin Brigade ceremony. President Clinton, General Walter Yates, and Colonel Jimmy Banks, Commander of the Troops, review troops in a jeep. President Clinton addresses the inactivation ceremony of the Berlin Brigade.

President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Chancellor Helmut Kohl, and Hannelore Kohl visit the Rathaus (City Hall) in Berlin. The Clintons and the Kohls watch the City Police Band perform. The Clintons and Kohls are met by Berlin Mayor Eberhard Diepgen and Hanna Renate Laurien, President of the Berlin House of Representatives. The group view the city from a balcony at Rathaus.

President Clinton participates in a trilateral meeting and press availability with European Union President Jacques Delors and Chancellor Helmut Kohl at the Reichstag. The group also participates in an expanded plenary session.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses a commencement ceremony at John F. Kennedy High School in Berlin. The First Lady is accompanied by Hannelore Kohl at the ceremony. The First Lady greets graduating students.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attends a luncheon with Hannelore Kohl at Charlottenburg Palace in Berlin. The First Lady and Hannelore Kohl walk to the Reichstag following the luncheon.

The Clintons depart Berlin via Air Force One en route to Andrews Air Force Base. The Clintons arrive at Andrews Air Force Base.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level.

While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
