Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 47) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment were created from May 17, 1994 through May 20, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Images responsive to this segment were previously processed in FOIA case number 2006-0310-F.

Photographs from May 17, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a discussion at Martin Luther King Middle School in Washington, DC on Brown V. Board of Education on the 40th anniversary of the decision. The President meets with students in a classroom. Photographed are Secretary of Education Richard Riley, Thurgood Marshall, Jr., and Ernie Green, among others. Also photographed in a separate room include Attorney General Janet Reno, Senator Paul Sarbanes, and Representative Steny Hoyer. The President addresses a school assembly in the school's gym, along with Bettie Lewis (School Principal). Also photographed is the President returning to the White House along with Andrew Friendly.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with staff prior to meeting with Prime Minister Gro Harlem Brundtland of Norway in the Oval Office of the White House. Also photographed is Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Strobe Talbott, Tony Lake, Mark Gearan, Jenonne Walker, George Stephanopoulos, and Samuel "Sandy" Berger. The President meets with Prime Minister Brundtland. Also photographed is the press pool and the Prime Minister signing the White House guest book.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with economic advisors in the Oval Office of the White House. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Leon Panetta, Laura Tyson, Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Robert Rubin, Alan Blinder, and Thomas "Mack" McLarty. Later the President meets with Admiral William Crowe, U.S. Ambassador-designate to Great Britain.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with the subcommittee chairs of the House Appropriations Committee in the Cabinet Room of the White House.

Photographs from May 18, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with Leon Panetta and Representative Steny Hoyer in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Also photographed are Robert Rubin and Thomas "Mack" McLarty.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with senior staff the Oval Office for a briefing prior to interviews with columnists. Present includes George Stephanopoulos, Dee Dee Myers, Mark Gearan, and David Gergen. President Clinton participates in an interview with William Raspberry (The Washington Post), Jack Nelson (Los Angeles Times), Michael Kinsley ("Crossfire") and Lars Erik Nelson (Newsday).

President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., meet with senior staff in the Family Theater for a briefing. Present include Secretary of Veterans Affairs Jesse Brown, Secretary of Transportation Federico Pena, Secretary of Health & Human Services Donna Shalala, Secretary of Housing and Urban Development Henry Cisneros, Attorney General Janet Reno, Leon Panetta, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, and Mickey Kantor.

President William Jefferson Clinton walks to the White House Library to participate in taping sessions. Present is Jonathan Prince.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Senator George Mitchell, Pat Griffin, George Stephanopoulos, Ira Magaziner, Mack McLarty, and Harold Ickes at the White House. Following the meeting the President speaks with Steve Ricchetti.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets various individuals and members of staff in separate meetings in the Oval Office of the White House. The President greets Ann Miller, Esther Williams, Mikhail Baryshnikov, Rahm Emanuel, Thomas “Mack” McLarty, Ira Magaziner, and Wayne Skinner, for the Whitman Walker Clinic. Later the President meets with Susan Johnson Cooke & John Shiffman. Later the President greets William Galston and Attorney Joel Hyatt in separate events.

President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., and Mary Elizabeth “Tipper” Gore address the Head Start reauthorization bill event in the East Room of the White House. Present on stage include Secretary of Health & Human Services Donna Shalala, Jeanne Kendall, Dr. Ansel Johnson, and Brian Rivera. Also present includes Senator George Mitchell, Representative Bob Gray, Senator Chris Dodd, Senator Paul Sarbanes, Senator Ted Kennedy, Representative James Morgan, and Senator Nancy Kassebaum, among others. Prior to the event the President, Vice President, and Christine Varney are photographed along the Colonnade.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton tapes messages in Room 459 of the Old Executive Office Building. Following the tapings, the First Lady proceeds to a meeting with health clinic directors in Room 100 of the OEOB. Present includes Walter Zell and Ira Magaziner, among others.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Sidney Blumental and Alexander Forger in separate meetings at the White House in the Map Room and Diplomatic Reception Room.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton & Mary Elizabeth “Tipper” Gore attend the Congressional Club First Ladies luncheon at the Omni Shoreham hotel in Washington DC. Photographed includes Mary Clement, Emily Shaw, Trish Lott, and Barbara Valentine. Trish Lott announces the charity that will receive a gift from the congressional club and presents a gift to the First Lady. Also photographed is Judy Collins, who greets the First Lady.

Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown and Loretta Avent pose with a group in the Indian treaty room at the White House. Also photographed is Paul Begala and Tom Rafferty in the Oval Office and Cabinet Room

Photographs from May 19, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton jogs in Washington, DC. The President passes the Lincoln Memorial, the Reflecting Pool, and the Tidal Basin. Photographed includes Governor Gaston Caperton, Nat Keohane, and Katrina Pflaumer.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a medal presentation for Major General Tom Montgomery in the Oval Office of the White House. Present include General John Shalikashvili, General Gordon Sullivan, General Carl Mundy, and Secretary of Defense William Perry.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets Senator George Mitchell and Bath Iron Works (General Dynamics) executives in the Oval Office of the White House. Following the event, the President proceeds to the Roosevelt Room to greet members of the National Farmers Union.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with senior staff prior to meeting with Prime Minister Narashimha Rao of India. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Tony Lake, Strobe Talbott, and Mark Gearan. Prime Minister Rao enters the Oval Office and meets with the President. The Press Pool is photographed in the Oval Office, including Mary Masserini. The President looks over a gift given to him by Prime Minister Rao. Also photographed is Nancy Hernreich. Following the Oval Office meeting the President and Prime Minister walk along the Colonnade to a meeting in the Old Family Dining Room. Present include Vice President Gore, Mickey Kantor, Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown, Tony Lake, Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, and Strobe Talbott. Following the meeting the President meets with staff in the Red Room. Present is Vice President Gore, Mark Gearan, and Dee Dee Myers. The President and Prime Minister participate in a press conference in the East Room. The President bids farewell to Prime Minister Rao as the Prime Minister leaves. Also photographed is Prime Minister Rao signing the White House guest book.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with health care representatives in the Roosevelt Room of the White House. Present include Representative Charlene Rydell and John Hart, among others.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a lunch meeting in the Map Room of the White House with David Wilhelm and guests.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets individuals in separate meetings in the Map Room of the White House, including Rabbi David Saperstein, Diana Carlin, and Ela Bhatt & Liz Moynihan.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets individuals in separate meetings in the Diplomatic Reception Room of the White House, including Jean Ariyoshi and Pamela Dennis.

Betty Currie and Ann McCoy greet guests in the White House.

Following his remarks, the President greets guests present at the event.

The President arrives at UCLA for the 75th Anniversary Convocation. The President delivers the keynote address. Photographed includes Charles E. Young (Chancellor; UCLA), Jack W. Peltason (President; UCLA), Mayor Richard Riordan, Carole Goldberg-Ambrose, Kate Anderson, Khosrow Khosravani, and Harold Shapiro, among others. Following his remarks, the President greets students and university officials.

President William Jefferson Clinton jogs along Ocean Avenue in Santa Monica, California.

Included are photographs of the Jacqueline Kennedy Onassis portrait in the White House.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
