Extent

Approximately 2,623 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 100) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment were created on October 20, 1994 through October 22, 1994, and October 24, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Photographs from October 20, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton & Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., converse with Leon Panetta and Pat Griffin in the Oval Office of the White House. Later in the Oval Office the President meets with Vice President Gore, Panetta, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, and Tony Lake.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Arthur Coia in the Oval Office of the White House.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Cabinet Room of the White House regarding his schedule. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Jack Quinn, and Stephanie Streett, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meet with Margaret Truman Daniels in the Map Room of the White House.

President William Jefferson Clinton confers with staff at the Park Plaza hotel including Bruce Lindsey prior to departing for Framingham High School in Framingham, Massachusetts. The President greets police & guests present, including Senator Edward Moore "Ted" Kennedy & Victoria Anne Kennedy. President Clinton proceeds to Framingham High School for the Elementary & Secondary Education Act bill signing event. Present includes Senator Kennedy, Senator John Kerry, Senator Jim Jeffords, Representative Edward Markey, Representative William Ford, Deputy Secretary Madeline Kunin and Jeremy Spector (Student Council President; Framingham HS). Following the event the President is photographed with Tom Trepasso, Brian McPartlin, Carter Wilkie, Stephen Goodin, Andrew Friendly, Harold Ickes, and staff & guests present.

President William Jefferson Clinton attends an event at Nevins Hall in Framingham, Massachusetts. Present includes Senator Edward Moore "Ted" Kennedy, Senator John Kerry, Joan Menard (Chair; Massachusetts Democratic Party), Representative Edward Markey, and Mark Roosevelt. The President converses with Bruce Lindsey, Marsha Scott, and guests outside Nevins Hall.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests & police on the tarmac prior to departing Boston Logan International Airport en route Andrews Air Force Base. The President disembarks Air Force One at Andrews Air Force Base. Photographed includes the arrival on Marine One with the Lincoln Memorial and Reflecting Pool in view.

President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attend a dinner at the White House. The President is photographed playing saxophone with the Army Air Corps Band "Airmen of Note." Also photographed are the President & First Lady greeting guests, guests dancing, and pictures of event table settings.

Photographs from October 21, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton address an International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers event at the IBEW Building in Washington, DC.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with staff and advisors in separate meetings in the Cabinet Room of the White House prior to a press conference for the President's upcoming trip to the Middle East. Photographed includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., George Stephanopoulos, Leon Panetta, Laura Tyson, Mark Gearan, Rahm Emanuel, Nancy Soderberg, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, Tony Lake,

Margaret Jane “Dee Dee” Myers, Erskine Bowles, Gene Sperling, John Podesta, Carol Rasco, Bruce Reed, and Joel Klein. The President proceeds to the Oval Office to continue the meetings. Photographed additionally includes Martin Indyk, Stephen Goodin, Alexis Herman, Amy Zisook, and Jack Gibbons, among others. The President proceeds to the Blue Room to hold prior to the press conference, then proceeds to the East Room. Further photographed includes Tom Ross & Don Baer. Following the press conference First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton congratulates the President in the Ground Floor Residence. The President walks along the Colonnade and greets a group with Loretta Avent in the West Garden Room.

President William Jefferson Clinton tapes a television spot in the Roosevelt Room of the White House. Present is Richard Strauss assisting the President. The President also tapes his weekly radio address. Following the taping the President proceeds to the Oval Office and greets guests present including Deb Doyle. The President confers with Mark Gearan and Don Baer in the Outer Oval Office.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in an interview with TIME Magazine in the Oval Office of the White House. Present is Michael Duffy. Photographer Diana Walker photographs the interview. Also present are Margaret Jane “Dee Dee” Myers & Nancy Soderberg.

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses a dinner at the Radisson Hotel in Alexandria, Virginia. Present is Governor Doug Wilder, Senator Charles Robb, and Representative Jim Moran, among others. The President returns to the White House and is greeted by Ann Stock & Sarah Farnsworth.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Ambassador Dick Gardner in the Map Room of the White House. Later the First Lady greets Dr. Ruth Westheimer in the West Wing.

Photographs from October 22, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton arrives in San Francisco, California.

President William Jefferson Clinton attends an event at Carlmont High School in San Francisco, California. The President signs the “Zero Tolerance For Guns In Schools” memorandum. Present includes Deputy Secretary of Education Madeline Kunin, Senator Dianne Feinstein, Representative Anna Eshoo, Mayor Tom Davids, Representative Tom Lantos, and school principal Michael Johnson, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton golfs at Lake Merced golf course in San Francisco, California. Present includes Ron Burkle, Jack Theimer, and Robert Trent Jones, Jr.

President William Jefferson Clinton attends an event at the Fairmont Hotel in San Francisco, California. Present includes Kathleen Brown & Senator Barbara Boxer.

President William Jefferson Clinton departs San Francisco, California en route Andrews Air Force Base. Photographed includes Madeleine Kunin.

Photographs from October 24, 1994 are as follows:

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Madame Simone Veil (French Minister of social, health & human affairs) in the Map Room of the White House. Also photographed includes Christophe LeCourtier, Patrick Villemur, and Sharon Gail Hemond.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
