Approximately 2,446 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0985-F (Segment 4) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1995 through December 31, 1995.

The photographs processed in this segment were created on January 12, 1995 through January 17, 1995. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Of particular focus is an observance of Martin Luther King, Jr. Day.

Records responsive to this case were previously processed in FOIA case numbers 2009-1399-F, 2019-0519-F, and 2020-0139-F.

Photographs from January 12, 1995 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton holds a meeting in the Oval Office of the White House regarding the economy of Mexico. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Leon Panetta, Secretary of the Treasury Robert Rubin, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, Bowman Cutter, Larry Summers, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Pat Griffin, and Laura Tyson. The President speaks with Secretary Rubin & Alan Greenspan. The President speaks to President Ernesto Zedillo of Mexico on the telephone regarding the Mexican Peso. Jim Reed is present. The Vice President speaks with Panetta & George Stephanopoulos.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a bipartisan congressional meeting in the Cabinet Room of the White House regarding the economy of Mexico. Present include Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Representative New Gingrich, Senator Robert Dole, Senator Thomas Daschle, Representative Richard Gephardt, Secretary of the Treasury Robert Rubin, Laura Tyson. Leon Panetta, Alan Greenspan, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, and Bowman Cutter, among others. The President speaks alone with Representative Gingrich, Cutter, Berger, and Rubin. Other individuals present meet & confer with one another. The President departs the meeting. Prior to the meeting the President speaks with Vice President Gore, Panetta, and Nancy Hernreich in the Oval Office.

Photographs from January 13, 1995 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Oval Office Dining Room with Don Baer, Leon Panetta, Paul Meyer, and George Stephanopoulos. The President tapes his weekly radio address. Afterwards the President speaks with Betty Currie, Kelly Craighead, Ginny Terzano, and Debi Schiff in the Outer Oval Office

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with Nancy Hernreich and Bruce Lindsey in the Diplomatic Reception Room entrance. The President walks across the South Lawn and boards Marine One. Marine One lifts off and flies towards the Washington Monument. The President and Secretary of Commerce Ronald Brown greet members of the United States' delegation who will accompany Secretary Brown on a trip to India. The President boards Air Force One and departs en route Cleveland, Ohio. Aboard the flight, the President converses with Samuel "Sandy" Berger, Ginny Terzano, and Antony Blinken.

President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport in Cleveland, Ohio. Greeting the President upon his arrival includes Mayor Michael White and Representative Louis Stokes.

President William Jefferson Clinton stops for lunch at Sokolowski's University Inn Restaurant. The President greets guests and restaurant personnel including Michael Sokolowski.

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses the White House Conference on Trade & Investment in Central & Eastern Europe at the Stouffer Renaissance Cleveland Hotel. The President greets attendees including business leaders. Present includes Secretary of Commerce Ronald Brown, Alexis Herman, Ginny Terzano, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, Nicholas Burns, and Antony Blinkin. Later the President meets with Council for Economic Education. Present includes Ruth Harkin, Ken Brody, and Joe Grandmaison. After the meeting the President proceeds to a meeting with press. Later the President greets & addresses guests.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with the editorial board of The Plain Dealer [newspaper] in the IX Jet Center Conference Room at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport. The President proceeds

to the tarmac and greets guests & volunteers prior to departure. Present includes Steve Ricchetti. Also photographed is the press pool. The President walks across the tarmac with Ginny Terzano and Samuel "Sandy" Berger. The President meets with Erskine Bowles and speaks on the telephone. Also photographed is Secretary of Commerce Ronald Brown and Bruce Lindsey.

President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Andrews Air Force Base. Present is Secretary of Commerce Ronald Brown. The President greets personnel. Later Marine One is photographed landing on the South Lawn landing zone at the White House. The President walks towards the White House. Photographed is Dr. Connie Mariano.

President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton walk towards Marine One on the South Lawn landing zone of the White House.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton and Chief Usher Gary Walters observe work in progress for ongoing renovations of the White House Blue Room. Later the First Lady greets Representative Newt Gingrich and Kathleen "Kit" Gingrich [mother of Representative Gingrich] in the Grand Foyer. At a later point the First Lady also greets Nancy Dickerson Whitehead, Mary Rose McGeady, Diana Auckerman, and Phylis Schless in separate events.

Photographs from January 14, 1995 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meet with staff & leading thinkers regarding Government. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Mary Elizabeth "Tipper" Gore, George Stephanopoulos, William Galston, Secretary of Housing & Urban Development Henry Cisneros, Leon Panetta, Don Baer, Bruce Reed, Elaine Kamarck, Al From, Alan Brinkley, Paul Starr, Stephen Carter, Theda Skocpol, Robert Putnam, Alan Wolfe, Benjamin Barber, Harry Boyte, Ian Oswald "Os" Guinness, William Marshall, and Eddie Williams. The President holds a separate meeting in his office in Laurel Cabin. Present includes Thomas "Mack" McLarty.

Photographs from January 15, 1995 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Chelsea Clinton walk on the grounds of Camp David. Also present includes Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Donna Kay McLarty, and Leon Panetta, among others.

Photographs from January 16, 1995 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton disembarks Marine One at Andrews Air Force Base. He boards Air Force One en route Denver, Colorado. The President arrives at Stapleton International Airport in Denver, Colorado and disembarks Air Force One. Present includes Secretary of Transportation Federico Pena, Pat Schroeder, Representative Ben Nighthorse Campbell, and Brian McPartlin. The President also greets airport personnel and Dave Carpenter.

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses the Martin Luther King, Jr., birthday commemoration at the Greek Amphitheatre in Denver, Colorado. Present includes Governor Roy Romer, Mayor Wellington Webb, Wilma Webb, Reverend Marshall Gourley, Rabbi Daniel Goldberger, Reverend Thomas English, Reverend Acen Phillips, Representative Patricia Schroeder, Secretary of

Transportation Federico Pena and Representative Ben Nighthorse Campbell. Also photographed includes the President greet police & drivers, dancers performing at the ceremony, and the President en route to the event.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a meeting regarding natural gas held with AMR Corporation Aviation company representatives at the Denver Stapleton International Airport. Present at the meeting includes Thomas “Mack” McLarty and Leon Panetta. Following the meeting the President converses with Bruce Lindsey, Stephen Goodin, Grace Garcia, Marsha Scott, Panetta, and McLarty.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests at Denver Stapleton International Airport prior to departure. The President boards Air Force One. Present is Thomas “Mack” McLarty, Leon Panetta, Secretary of Transportation Federico Pena, and John Emerson.

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses an event with opinion leaders at the Sheraton Miramar Hotel in Santa Monica, California. Present includes Leon Panetta, Ricki Seidman, Marsha Scott, and Barbra Streisand. The President greets drivers & volunteers.

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses a Martin Luther King, Jr., day event at the community building in Los Angeles, California. Present includes Representative Maxine Waters, Mayor Richard Riordan, and Brenda Shockley. The President meets with members of the community and greets guests including Cicely Tyson, Marla Gibbs, Robert Hooks, Linda Hopkins, Rosa Parks, and White House photographer Sharon Farmer.

Photographs from January 17, 1995 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton disembarks Air Force One at McClellan Air Force Base in Sacramento, California. Present includes James Lee Witt, Secretary of Housing & Urban Development Henry Cisneros, Secretary of Transportation Federico Pena, and Leon Panetta. The President is en route Roseville, California to view flood damaged neighborhoods. The President visits neighborhoods in Roseville damaged by flooding, and visits with local families. The President delivers remarks to the community. Present includes Representative Victor “Vic” Herbert Fazio, Jr. Later the President visits the local Methodist Church and greets people along the motorcade route and at a dairy stand.

President William Jefferson Clinton jogs in Santa Monica, California. Present is John Emerson.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets at the Sheraton Miramar hotel in Santa Monica, California with entertainers about leadership for economic infusion into the black communities of Los Angeles. Present includes Danny Akewell, Quincy Jones, Debbie Allen, and Cicely Tyson, among others. Later the President meets with Rosa Parks. Also photographed includes Steve Goodin, Norm Nixon, Danny Bakewell, and Debbie Allen.

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses an event on Oviatt Library Lawn at California State University, Northridge in Los Angeles, California to mark the anniversary of the California earthquake. Present includes Dr. Blenda Wilson, Mayor Richard Riordan, Secretary of Transportation Federico Pena, Secretary of Housing & Urban Development Henry Cisneros, and James Lee Witt, among others. The President greets volunteers and little league baseball players. Also photographed is the President speaking with Michael McCurry, Bruce Lindsey, and Dave Carpenter.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attends a performance of the National Symphony Orchestra in Washington, DC. Photographed includes Leonard Slatkin, James Wolfensohn, and Senator Mark Hatfield.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
