2. FOLLOWING THE TRIUMPHAL RETURN OF PRESIDENT ARISTIDE ON OCTOBER 15, IT IS ESSENTIAL THAT THE POLITICAL MOMENTUM NOT BE LOST. IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN BOTH THE SUBSTANCE AND APPEARANCE OF FORWARD MOVEMENT, THERE NEED TO BE ALMOST DAILY EVENTS WHICH GIVE HAITIANS THE SENSE THAT THE PROCESS OF POLITICAL, ECONOMIC, AND SOCIAL TRANSFORMATION IS MOVING AHEAD. THIS MESSAGE PRESENTS THE MISSION'S FIRST CUT AT A WEEK-BY-WEEK LISTING OF EVENTS AND DEVELOPMENTS WHICH MAKE UP A TIME LINE FOR THE FIRST 100 DAYS. IN SOME CASES, TIMING IS APPROXIMATE OR REPRESENTS A RECOMMENDATION FOR A VISIT OR ACTIVITY. MISSION INTENDS TO UPDATE THIS CHART ON A WEEKLY BASIS.

2. SUMMARY: THIS IS THE WEEKLY UPDATE FORESEEN IN REFTEL WHICH PROVIDED A 100-DAY LISTING OF EVENTS AND DEVELOPMENTS FOLLOWING THE RETURN OF PRESIDENT ARISTIDE ON OCTOBER 15. END SUMMARY

3. DURING THE FIRST WEEK, ARISTIDE BEGAN MEETING WITH A WIDE SPECTRUM OF HAITIANS AND CONTINUED HIS CALLS FOR NATIONAL RECONCILIATION. AID/AA MARK SCHNEIDER ANNOUNCED USG FIRST-YEAR ASSISTANCE FOR HAITI, AND ICITAP PREPARE CAMP D'APPLICATION FOR THE FIRST CLASS OF INTERIM PUBLIC SECURITY FORCE TRAINEES DRAWN FROM THE HAITIAN ARMED

FORCES. THE HAITIAN SENATE PASSED A LAW BANNING PARAMILITARY GROUPS AND CONTINUED WORK ON THE TERRITORIAL COLLECTIVITIES, WHILE THE CHAMBER OF DEPUTIES STRUGGLED WITH THE POLICE LAW. THE FIRST POST-EMBARGO SHIPMENT OF FUELS ARRIVED, WITH IMMEDIATE DISTRIBUTION IN PORT AU PRINCE.
