SUBJECT: Your Telephone Call To President Salinas

Purpose

To acknowledge Mexican President Carlos Salinas' concerns over the passage of California's Proposition 187.

Background

The Mexicans are extremely agitated by the passage of this measure. Opposition has been articulated across the political spectrum and throughout the media. Senior Mexican officials, including Foreign Minister Tello, have described the proposition as racist, xenophobic and anti-Mexican. Salinas has also sharply criticized the measure, most recently in his November 1 State of the Union address. Mexicans have organized boycotts against cross-border shopping. Several protests have been held in front of our embassy and consulates. We want to prevent an increase in such activity and reduce the possibility of their turning violent.

Your call to Salinas will help temper the GOM reaction and head off unhelpful statements by Salinas and other senior Mexican officials. It will also be helpful in light of your November 23 luncheon with President-elect Zedillo at the White House.

POINTS TO BE MADE
TELEPHONE CONVERSATION WITH
MEXICAN PRESIDENT CARLOS SALINAS

- Share your disappointment Proposition 187 was passed in California.
- This was a California state initiative. No national effect.
- Litigation will delay any implementation for foreseeable future.
- Attorney General Reno assessing what actions by the federal government might be appropriate.
- In the meantime, we should try to prevent emotions unleashed by this from spilling over into other areas of our relationship.
- Look forward to meeting you in Bogor.
- I would like to publicly endorse your candidacy to head the World Trade Organization while we are at APEC if you think that would be helpful to you at this time.
- Looking forward to meeting with President-elect Zedillo in Washington on November 23.
- I want to talk with you about Summit and matters we discussed before, when I return from Asia.
- (If asked) Hope to get back to you shortly regarding the Anti-Abduction Treaty.
