Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 60) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken June 20, 1994, through June 23, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Photographs from June 20, 1994, are as follows:

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet guests in the Blue Room attending the “Aretha Franklin: In Performance at the White House” concert with Lou Rawls. Guests include Delegate Eleanor Holmes Norton, Senator Jay Rockefeller, Mandy Grunwald, Dee Dee Myers, Grant Hill, Representative Bobby Rush, Donna Brazile, Liz Robbins, and others.

Photographs from June 21, 1994, are as follows:

President Clinton goes jogging in Washington, D.C. with Mayor Marty Chavez of Albuquerque, New Mexico, and Astronauts Steven Hawley and Stephen Oswald.

President Clinton meets with President Yoweri Museveni of Uganda in the West Wing. Tony Lake, Don Steinberg, and others are present at the meeting.

President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with President Arpad Goncz of Hungary and President Michal Kovac of Slovakia.

President Clinton greets the Gatlin family in the Oval Office.

President Clinton arrives at the J.W. Marriott Hotel in Washington and greets hotel personnel. President Clinton greets John Ong, outgoing Chair of the Business Roundtable and CEO of BF. Goodrich, and John Snow, incoming Chair and President and CEO of CSX Corporation. President Clinton addresses the Business Roundtable event. President Clinton returns to the White House with Robert Rubin. President Clinton and Robert Rubin talk to Mack McLarty on the Colonnade.

Mack McLarty greets Reverend Jerry Lee Drace, Becky Drace, and Andrew Drace in his West Wing office.

President Clinton jokes in the Cabinet Room with Representative Jack Brooks prior to the Congressional meeting relating to the Crime Bill. Vice President Albert Gore, Leon Panetta, Representative Richard Gephardt, George Stephanopoulos, Mack McLarty, Ron Klain, and others are present in the Cabinet Room.

President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Senator John Danforth.

Photographs from June 22, 1994, are as follows:

President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with King Hussein of Jordan. Tony Lake, Dennis Ross, and others are present at the meeting. Views of the White House Press Pool covering the meeting. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Queen Noor of Jordan in the residence. President Clinton and King Hussein join the First Lady and Queen Noor for lunch in the residence. The Clintons talk with King Hussein and Queen Noor in the Diplomatic Reception Room. The Clintons wave goodbye to King Hussein and Queen Noor at the South Portico. President Clinton talks with Dennis Ross, Tony Lake, and Martin Indyk and they walk along the Colonnade towards the West Wing.

President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Christine Varney and George Stephanopoulos.

President Clinton attends and delivers remarks at the Commemoration of the 50th Anniversary of the GI Bill at the Veteran's Administration in Washington. Ceremony participants include Secretary Jesse Brown, Representative Frank Murkowski, Representative Sonny Montgomery, and Postmaster General Marvin Runyon, Garnett Shropshire, World War II Veteran, and Hugo Mendoza, Persian Gulf Veteran. Postmaster General Runyon presides over the commemorative stamp cancellation. President Clinton talks alone with Hershel Gober at the event.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at the U.S. Capitol. The First Lady greets staff members in Senator George Mitchell's office. The First Lady greets Governor Lawton Chiles and Senators during their message group meeting. Meeting participants include Senator Edward "Ted" Kennedy, Senator Barbara Mikulski, Senator Bob Graham, Senator Jay Rockefeller, Senator Patty Murray, Senator Paul Simon. Senator Carl Levin, Senator David Pryor, Senator Harris Wofford, Senator Barbara Boxer, Senator Tom Harkin, and others. The First Lady stands with Senator George Mitchell as he makes a statement to the press in the hallway. The First Lady talks with Senator Paul Wellstone and Senator Edward Kennedy in the hallway. The First Lady returns to the White House and is accompanied by Lisa Caputo. The First Lady talks with Lisa Caputo, Steve Ricchetti, and Chris Jennings on the South Lawn driveway.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets an unidentified couple in the Diplomatic Reception Room. They present the First Lady carved wooden walking sticks.

President Clinton greets a Religious Freedom Act group in the Oval Office.

President Clinton greets people on the street in Washington prior to his jogging outing. President Clinton goes jogging along the Potomac River with military aide Bob Walters.

President Clinton stands outside the Lower Press Office prior to his press conference. Andrew Friendly, Dee Dee Myers, George Stephanopoulos, Bob Boorstin, and Tony Lake are present in Lower Press Office. President Clinton gives a press conference in the Press Briefing Room. The President and Tony Lake stand alone together near the doorway at the end of the press conference.

President Clinton tapes video messages in the Old Executive Office Building (OEOB) studio for Summer Anti-Drunk Driving PSA; Message to Berliners; Message to the Baltics; Shriners Annual Convention; Radio Talk Show Hosts Convention, and others. Jonathan Prince, Susan Brophy, Andrew Friendly, and others are present for the tapings.

President Clinton meets with Greg Palmer, Alexis Herman, Susan Thomases, Phil Lader, Robert Rubin, and others in the Oval Office.

President Clinton and Secretary Ron Brown participate in a Travel and Tourism meeting in the Diplomatic Reception Room.

President Clinton talks on the telephone in the Oval Office with President Kim Yong Sam of South Korea.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attend a Saxophone Club reception in Washington, D.C. Reception participants include David Wilhelm, Chairman of the Democratic National Committee (DNC), Vernon Jordan, Ann Jordan, and Paula Poundstone. The President addresses the reception at the Omni Shoreham Hotel.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attend a Democratic National Committee (DNC) Gala at the Washington Hilton Hotel. Gala participants include DNC Chairman David Wilhelm, Vernon Jordan, Ann Jordan, and Kenny Loggins and his band. President Clinton addresses the Gala. President Clinton greets guests at the Gala including band members of Hootie and the Blowfish, and others.

President Clinton talks alone with Chelsea Clinton on the Colonnade.

President Clinton confers with Tony Lake, George Stephanopoulos, Mack McLarty, Nancy Soderberg, Rahm Emanuel, Andrew Friendly, and others.

Photographs from June 23, 1994, are as follows:

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
