### All Audio and Video Recordings of the Hollywood Gala Salute to President William Jefferson Clinton on August 12, 2000

#### Extent

Five White House Television Office digital betacam format tapes with approximately 121 minutes of run time and One White House Communications Agency cassette tape with approximately 13 minutes and four seconds of run time.

#### Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. #### Scope and Content

FOIA 2025-0081-F is a request for all audio & video recordings of a Hollywood Gala Salute to President William Jefferson Clinton. The event took place on August 12, 2000 at the Ken Roberts estate in Los Angeles, California. The gala took place on the front lawn of the Ken Roberts estate. Participants at the gala include Stan Lee, Patti LaBelle, Goldie Hawn, Sugar Ray, Red Buttons, Jimmy Smits, Toni Braxton, Anjelica Huston, Howie Mandel, Whoopi Goldberg, Melissa Etheridge, David Spade, Dylan McDermott, Alfree Woodard, Michael Bolton, Jack Lemmon, Cher, Muhammad Ali, Paul Anka, Gregory Peck, Diana Ross, Mary Steenburgen, and Ted Danson.

### **System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in two collections and two series, Clinton Presidential Records: Audio Recordings of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein – Audio Recordings Relating to the Clinton Administration, and Clinton Presidential Records: Video Recordings of the White House Television Office and the series therein – Video Recordings Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing was done at the individual item level for both audio recordings and video recordings. While this method maintains run time integrity for audio & video recordings, it frequently results in the incidental processing of audio and video material that is not wholly responsive to the subject area.
