



## **Inventory for FOIA Request 2016-0984-F AV Segment 22 (1994, P13200-P13299)**

**All Presidential series photographs from the Clinton Administration taken from March 11, 1994, through March 14, 1994.**

### **Extent**

Approximately 2,607 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

### **Scope and Content**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 22) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment were created from March 11, 1994 through March 14, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff and others for the time period processed.

### **Photographs from March 11, 1994 are as follows:**

President William Jefferson Clinton in the Old Executive Office Building announces the Summit of the Americas. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Assistant Secretary General of the Organization of American States Christopher Thomas, Director of External Relations of the Inter-

American Development Bank Muni Figueres, and Governor Lawton Chiles. Also photographed includes Hattie Babbitt and Thomas “Mack” McLarty, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attend a reception for the National Newspaper Association on the State Floor of the White House. The President and First Lady greet guests for the event in the Diplomatic Reception room.

Phil Lader & Linda Lader are photographed on the North Grounds of the White House.

**Photographs from March 12, 1994 are as follows:**

President William Jefferson Clinton jogs around Washington, DC. The President is photographed outside of the Reflecting Pool.

President William Jefferson Clinton delivers his weekly radio address from the Oval Office of the White House. Following the address, the President greets guests in attendance including Dianna Pierce, Dana Lawrence, Roy Spence, Pat Griffin, and Senator Paul Simon, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in an interview with Bob Ranking for the Detroit Free Press in the Oval Office of the White House. Later the President and Tony Lake hold a bovine painting.

President William Jefferson Clinton golfs with Kevin O’Keefe in Fairfax, Virginia.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in an interview with Alexander Wolff and Greg Kelly for Sports Illustrated magazine. As part of the interview the President participates in a photo shoot palming a basketball in front of the White House. Also photographed includes First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Nancy Hernreich, Steve Cohen, Josh King, Mark Gearan, and Dee Dee Myers.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets the cabinet secretaries’ chiefs of staff in the Oval Office of the White House. Photographed includes Christine Varney and Thomas “Mack” McLarty.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a videotaping session in the Map Room of the White House for the Connecticut Jefferson Jackson dinner.

**Photographs from March 13, 1994 are as follows:**

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with President Luis Alberto Lacalle of Uruguay in the Oval Office of the White House. Also present are Strobe Talbott, Tony Lake, and Sandy Berger.

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with Lloyd Cutler and Joel Klein in the Oval Office of the White House. Later the President looks at a Chuck Berry album on the Resolute Desk. Also photographed includes Nancy Hernreich and Thomas “Mack” McLarty. The President proceeds to the Outer Oval Office and speaks with David Gergen and Jodi Greenstone. Following the conversations, the President is photographed along the Colonnade.

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with Bruce Lindsey, David Gergen, and Thomas “Mack” McLarty prior to departing the White House. The President greets people present on the South Lawn prior to departing en route Detroit, Michigan. The President greets guest Melinda Bates, along with other guests present. The President walks with Bruce Lindsey to Marine One. The President arrives at Andrews Air Force Base and embarks upon Air Force One. On the flight the President calls President

Hafez al-Assad of Syria. Also photographed are Sandy Berger and Dee Dee Myers. Air Force One arrives at Selfridge Air National Guard Base. The President greets Senator Don Riegel, Senator Carl Levin, Representative David Bonior, Representative John Corvers, Mayor Dennis Archer, Mayor Quinnie Cody, Richard Austin, Wayne County Executive Ed McNamara, Major General E. Gordon Stump, Marie Stump, and Hal Ewing, among others. The President also greets "Faces of the New Economy" participants including Steve Choate, Frank Rapley, Debbie Collation, Bruce Wirtanen, Ocelia Williams, Kathy Price, Harold Wright, and Anna Satur.

President William Jefferson Clinton attends an event at Focus: HOPE. The President tours the advanced technology center and proceeds to deliver remarks to guests present. Photographed includes Father William Cunningham (Founder & Director, Focus: HOPE), Associate Director Eleanor Josaitis, Donald Hutchinson, Senator Carl Levin, and Representative Barbara-Rose Collins, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton attends the Detroit host committee reception. Present includes Governor John Engler, Mayor Dennis Archer, Representative John Dingell, and Ambassador Jim Blanchard. Later the President greets G-7 foreign ministers at the Westin Hotel.

**Photographs from March 14, 1994 are as follows:**

President William Jefferson Clinton jogs along Belle Isle in Detroit, Michigan. Accompanying the President includes Vice President Al Gore, Jr. and Mayor Dennis Archer, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton attends a breakfast with G-7 foreign ministers at the Westin Hotel in Detroit, Michigan. Present are Vice President Al Gore, Jr., Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Secretary of Labor Robert Reich, Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown, and Laura Tyson, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses the G-7 Jobs Conference at the Fox Theatre in Detroit, Michigan. Following his remarks, the President attends a reception. Photographed includes Vice President Al Gore, Jr., Wendy Smith, and Liz Robbins.

President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Detroit Diesel in Detroit, Michigan. The President tours the assembly line. The President is accompanied by Roger Penske, Ludvik Koci, Owen Bieber, and Bob King. The President greets workers & staff, and later addresses participants present. Also photographed includes Representative John Conyers and Senator Don Riegle.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets drivers and others present at Selfridge Air National Guard Base in Detroit, Michigan. Photographed includes Anthony Triplett and Sam Myers, among others. The President arrives at Logan International Airport in Boston, Massachusetts. The President is met by Governor William Weld, Mayor Thomas Menino, Senator Ted Kennedy, Senator John Kerry, and Representative Joe Moakley. The press pool questions the President on the tarmac.

President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at the Boston Park Plaza Hotel. He is met by Roger Saunders, Tedd Saunders, Norma Stilson, and Avram Stilson. The President participates in a meeting regarding health care at the hotel. Later, the President delivers remarks at a Democratic National Committee event at the hotel.

President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Rowes Wharf in Boston, Massachusetts. Present includes Senator Ted Kenney, Vicki Kennedy, Senator John Kerry, Representative Joe Moakley, and Mayor Thomas Menino. The President delivers remarks from the wharf.

## **System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
