



## **Inventory for FOIA Request 2016-0984-F AV Segment 75 (1994, P18500-P18599)**

**All Presidential series photographs from the Clinton Administration taken on July 29, 1994 through July 31, 1994.**

### **Extent**

Approximately 2,590 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

### **Scope and Content**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 75) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment were created on July 29, 1994 through July 31, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Select material responsive to this segment was previously processed in FOIA case # 2022-0199-F.

**Photographs from July 29, 1994 are as follows:**

President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Map Room of the White House with David Wilhelm, Harold Ickes, and Leon Panetta, among others, regarding health care. Later in the Map Room the President meets with Hugh Price (Urban League). Also present are Bob Rubin and Alexis Herman.

President William Jefferson Clinton in the Oval Office of the White House confers with George Stephanopoulos, Don Baer, Jonathan Prince, David Kusnet, and Christine Heenan. Later the President meets with Laura Tyson, Alice Rivlin, Stephanopoulos, Bob Rubin, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Leon Panetta, and Joseph Stiglitz regarding the economy. Later First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton enters the Oval Office and whispers to the President.

President Clinton greets guests in the Oval Office & West Wing of the White House, including Walter McKay, Dawn Friedkin, and Melinda Bates.

President William Jefferson Clinton & Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., meet with Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Secretary of Defense William Perry, Leon Panetta in the Oval Office of the White House. Secretary Christopher, Secretary Perry, and Tony Lake converse in the Cabinet Room following the meeting.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., General John Shalikashvili, and Tony Lake in the Oval Office. The President proceeds to a press conference in the Press Briefing Room of the White House regarding Operation Support Hope aid to Rwanda. Also present are General Shalikashvili and Lake. Prior to the meeting the President confers with Margaret Jane "Dee Dee" Myers, George Stephanopoulos, Bob Boorstin, General Shalikashvili, and Lake outside the Lower Press Office.

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses a Boys Nation event in the East Room of the White House. Present includes Thomas Whitehead (President; Boys Nation) Stephen Breyer, Senator Orrin Hatch, Senator Ted Kennedy, and Joel Klein.

President William Jefferson Clinton confers with Stan Greenberg, Mandy Grunwald, and George Stephanopoulos prior to a taping session in the White House Library. Following the event the President greets guests in the Grand Foyer.

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses a meeting with Youth For Christ in Room 450 of the Old Executive Office Building. Prior to the event the President meets with Flo McAfee, Linda Lader, Phil Lader, and Dan Wexler. Later the President proceeds to Room 459 where the President participates in a satellite feed message to the Unity '94 Convention taking place in Atlanta, Georgia. Present includes Alexis Herman, Andrew Friendly, and Joe Velesquez. Following the feed the President tapes a message for the Southwest Voter Registration Education Project.

President William Jefferson Clinton tapes his weekly radio address in the Roosevelt Room of the White House. Later the President tapes radio actualities at his desk in the Oval Office. Photographed includes Richard Strauss & George Stephanopoulos. Later the President greets radio address guests.

Stephen Breyer, Lloyd Cutler, Joel Klein, Phil Lader, and staff watch the Breyer for Associate Supreme Court Justice confirmation vote on television in the West Wing of the White House. Also photographed is Debi Schiff speaking on the telephone. President William Jefferson Clinton congratulates Breyer on his confirmation. Also present is Senator Ted Kenney, Alexis Herman, and Senator Orrin Hatch.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses a group of women tribal leaders in the Indian Treaty Room of the White House. Present includes Secretary of Energy Hazel O'Leary, Janet Reno, Alice Rivlin, Brooke Shearer, Debbie Doxtator (Oneida Tribe), Sue Shaffer (Cow Creek Band of Umpqua of Oregon), Assistant Secretary for Indian Affairs Ada Deer. The First Lady and attendees participate in a group photo opportunity outside the Old Executive Office Building.

**Photographs from July 30, 1994 are as follows:**

President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton confer with Margaret Jane "Dee Dee" Myers, George Stephanopoulos, and Bruce Lindsey prior to departing the White House. The President and First Lady walk towards Marine One on the South Lawn landing zone and depart en route Andrews Air Force Base and Kansas City, Missouri. The President and First Lady arrive at the Kansas City International Airport. Also present are Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Second Lady Mary Elizabeth "Tipper" Gore, Governor Mel Carnahan, Representative Alan Wheat, Paul Begala, and Jack Quinn, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., and Second Lady Mary Elizabeth "Tipper" Gore arrive at the Truman Courthouse in Independence, Missouri. The President confers with Kirk Hanlin and reviews his speech. The Clintons and Gores participate in a health care express rally at the courthouse. Present include Governor Mel Carnahan and Representative Alan Wheat, among others. The President greets guests present including Willie Nelson and state troopers. Following the event the President and First Lady proceed to the Truman Presidential Library & Museum. The Clintons tour the exhibits and Oval Office replica. Present is Truman Library Director Dr. Ben Zorbist.

President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet guests, police, and volunteers on the tarmac at Kansas City International Airport. Present is Kirk Hanlin. The Clintons depart Kansas City en route Cleveland, Ohio. The Clintons arrive at Cleveland-Hopkins International Airport. The Clintons greet guests present on the tarmac including Joel Hyatt, Representative Louis Stokes, and Bob Walters, among others. The President address guests present.

**Photographs from July 31, 1994 are as follows:**

President William Jefferson Clinton greets Senator Joseph Biden outside of the White House.

**System of Arrangement**
