### **All Presidential series photographs from the Clinton Administration taken from December 23, 1994 & January 3, 1995, through January 10, 1995**

#### **Extent**

Approximately 2,148 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

#### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

#### **Scope and Content**

FOIA 2016-0985-F (Segment 2) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1995, through December 31, 1995. The photographs processed in this segment were created on December 23, 1994; January 3, 1995, through January 10, 1995. Select photo contact sheets from January 9, 1995, were previously processed in case 2009-1398-F. Photo contact sheet P23338 contains one photo from December 23, 1994. Photo contact sheet P23387 photo negatives were transferred by the White House Photo Office to the

Curator's Office photo collection as F4250. The Finding Aid inventory will reflect the previously processed photo contact sheets.

The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

**Photographs from December 23, 1994, are as follows:**

President Clinton goes Christmas shopping at Georgetown Park Mall in Washington, D.C.

**Photographs from January 3, 1995, are as follows:**

President Clinton participates in duck hunting in Cotton Plant, Arkansas. President Clinton greets and talks with friends at a residence in Cotton Plant. President Clinton talks to the Press Pool after hunting.

President Clinton visits the Cotham Mercantile Store in Scott, Arkansas. The President talks with the store owners and Arkansas State Troopers. President Clinton talks to reporters outside the store.

President Clinton arrives at Rose Hill Cemetery in Hope, Arkansas and visits his mother Virginia's gravesite.

**Photographs from January 4, 1995, are as follows:**

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visit William Jefferson Clinton Elementary Magnet School in Little Rock. The Clintons meet with students at the school. President Clinton addresses the students and others. The President is presented a portrait of himself following his address. The Clintons view memorabilia in the hallway of the school.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet friends and guests at the airport in Little Rock prior to departing. President Clinton jokes with staff aboard and reads excerpts from a book during his flight on Air Force One. Stephanie Streett, Marsha Scott, and others are present on the flight. The Clintons disembark Marine One on the South Lawn of the White House following their trip to Arkansas.

President Clinton talks on the telephone in the Oval Office to Representative Richard Gephardt and Representative Dick Armey. George Stephanopoulos, Pat Griffin, and Stephen Goodin watch television in the Outer Oval Office.

President Clinton reads and works at his desk in the Oval Office. President Clinton confers in the Oval Office with George Stephanopoulos and Mark Gearan.

President Clinton participates in an interview in the Roosevelt Room with KELO-TV South Dakota. Prior to the interview the President talks with George Stephanopoulos and Lorrie McHugh.

President Clinton greets Mike McCurry and Debra McCurry in the Oval Office Dining Room. President Clinton and the McCurry's talk with George Stephanopoulos, Mark Gearan, and Leon Panetta. President Clinton announces Mike McCurry as his new Press Secretary, replacing Dee Dee Myers, in the Press Briefing Room.

President Clinton participates in an interview with Peter Jennings, ABC News, in the Oval Office. Leon Panetta and Mark Gearan are present in the Oval Office. Prior to the interview

President Clinton participates in a schedule meeting in the Cabinet Room with Billy Webster, Leon Panetta, Harold Ickes, George Stephanopoulos, Mark Gearan, Nancy Hrenreich, Anne Walley, and Stephanie Streett.

**Photographs from January 7, 1995, are as follows:**

President Clinton delivers his weekly radio address in the Oval Office. Following the radio address President Clinton greets guests in the Oval Office. President Clinton talks with Richard Strauss and Heather Beckel.

**Photographs from January 8, 1995, are as follows:**

President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Chelsea Clinton arrive at for church services at Foundry United Methodist Church in Washington, D.C. The Clintons depart from the church following the service.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton go golfing at Army Navy Country Club in Virginia.

President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with advisers regarding his upcoming State of the Union address. Meeting participants include Vice President Albert Gore, Leon Panetta, Mike McCurry, David Dreyer, Bob Boorstin, William Glaston, Don Baer, and George Stephanopoulos.

President Clinton talks on the telephone in the Oval Office with Prime Minister Willem "Wim" Kok of the Netherlands.

President Clinton talks alone in the Outer Oval Office with Don Baer. President Clinton reads a document and talks with Betty Currie in the Outer Oval Office. President Clinton talks with Vicki Radd in the Outer Oval Office.

**Photographs from January 10, 1995, are as follows:**

Bobby Jones, David Jones, and others visit the Oval Office.

Prior to departing the West Wing, President Clinton reads a newspaper with Leon Panetta and talks with Nancy Hernreich, Betty Currie, Harold Ickes, and Stephen Goodin. President Clinton greets people on the South Lawn prior to departing for Galesburg, Illinois. The President crosses the South Lawn and boards Marine One for departure.

**System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level.

While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
