



## **Inventory for FOIA Request 2016-0984-F AV Segment 120 (1994, P23000-P23099)**

**All Presidential series photographs from the Clinton Administration taken on December 16, 1994 through December 20, 1994.**

### **Extent**

Approximately 2,472 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

### **Scope and Content**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 120) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment were created on December 16, 1994 through December 20, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

**Photographs from December 16, 1994 are as follows:**

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a welfare reform briefing in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present includes Carol Rasco, Robert Rubin, George Stephanopoulos, Bruce Reed, and Mark Gearan, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in an environmental briefing in the Oval Office of the White House. Present includes Katie McGinty, Leon Panetta, and Pat Griffin, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton tape a holiday message, a Disney message, and a Partnership for a Drug-Free America message in the Diplomatic Reception Room of the White House. Present is Socks the cat who sits on the First Lady's lap. Dave Anderson is present.

President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton address staff on the South Lawn of the White House. Leon Panetta is present with the Clintons. Staff greeted following remarks include Loretta Avent, Claude Taylor, Sam Myers, Melinda Bates, and Dave Carpenter, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests in the Oval Office of the White House. Present includes Johnnie Bryan (J.B.) Hunt, Johnelle Hunt, David Matthews, Mary Beth Matthews, "J.T." Rose, Nannice Rose, and an unidentified individual. Present is Leon Panetta.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton and Socks the cat visit with children during a Christmas event at the National Medical Center in Washington, DC. The First Lady greets hospital personnel and participates in a large event in a commons room. Santa Claus visits the children, and the First Lady receives a hug from a girl.

President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet guests in the Diplomatic Reception Room of the White House prior to a dinner in the East Room. Also photographed are chefs Roland Mesnier & Franette McCullough preparing desserts in the Grand Foyer, and the Marine Band strings playing in Cross Hall.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets a group of individuals in the State Dining Room of the White House. Later the First Lady greets Lissa Muscatine and her twin babies.

**Photographs from December 17, 1994 are as follows:**

President William Jefferson Clinton & Secretary of Education Richard Riley deliver a weekly radio address at the Northern Virginia Community College. Prior to the address the President meets with Carter Wilkie, William Galston, and Don Baer. Following the address the President greets guests in attendance. Also photographed is Wendy Smith. The President looks at various pieces of artwork by students.

President William Jefferson Clinton & Hillary Rodham Clinton greet guests at a Christmas reception in the Diplomatic Reception Room of the White House. Photographed includes Stephanie Streett, Dick Kelley, David Matthews, Jamie Williams, and Barbara Kinney. The President & First Lady greet the Military ensemble in the Ground Floor Residence and proceed to an expanded reception in the East Room.

Miscellaneous photographs include a uniformed Secret Service agent searching the Rose Garden of the White House for bullets fired at the White House. Socks the Cat looks on from the Outer Oval Office.

**Photographs from December 18, 1994 are as follows:**

President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Chelsea Clinton depart Foundry United Methodist Church in Washington, DC, after attending service.

President William Jefferson Clinton golfs at Army Navy Country Club in Arlington, Virginia.

President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Chelsea Clinton greet guests for a Christmas reception in the Diplomatic Reception Room of the White House. Photographed includes Vernon Jordan and Carolyn Huber, among others. Santa Claus holds a girl, while children dance in the East Room. The Clintons pose for a family photograph in front of the Christmas tree.

**Photographs from December 19, 1994 are as follows:**

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a budget briefing in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Secretary of Labor Robert Reich, Robert Rubin, Laura Tyson, George Stephanopoulos, Leon Panetta, Alice Rivlin, Jack Quinn, Gene Sperling, and Bowman Cutter.

President William Jefferson Clinton delivers a press conference regarding the budget in Room 450 of the Old Executive Office Building. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Secretary of Housing & Urban Development Henry Cisneros, Secretary of Transportation Federico Pena, and Alice Rivlin, among others. Prior to proceeding to the press conference, the President meets with the Vice President, Leon Panetta, Jack Quinn, George Stephanopoulos, and Elaine Kamarck in the Oval Office. Mark Gearan and Don Baer are also photographed. Following the press conference the President speaks with Reverend William Hybels and Lynne Hybels. Also photographed are Jason Goldberg and Sharon Kennedy.

President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at the Department of Justice in Washington, DC for a Top Cop event. Present includes Attorney General Janet Reno, Deputy Attorney General Jamie Gorelick, Associate Attorney General John Schmidt, Jerry Sanders (Police Chief; San Diego, CA), Lee Brown, and Joseph Brann. Brann is announced in a ceremony as "Top Cop" by the President and is sworn in as director of C.O.P.S. (Community Oriented Policing Services).

President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests in the Oval Office of the White House in separate meetings, including Abby Ginzberg, Secretary of Commerce Ronald Brown, Jack Gibbons with Science & Technology medal winners, Tom Smith, Counts Smith, Robert Caldwell, and Peggy Caldwell. Later the President meets with Jodi Greenstone in the West Wing.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Peter Kovler and Carolyn Huber in separate events in the West Wing.

President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets guests at a Christmas reception in the White House. The President & First Lady listen to a performance in the Ground Floor Residence. Photographed include Ann Stock.

Miscellaneous photographs include both Dee Dee Myers and Joan Baggett posing with staff for group photographs.

**Photographs from December 20, 1994 are as follows:**

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a meeting regarding welfare reform in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Carol Rasco, Secretary of Health & Human Services Donna Shalala, William Galston, and George Stephanopoulos, among others.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Lieutenant Governor-elect Gray Davis and Tom Epsetin in the Map Room of the White House.

**System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration.
