### **Extent**

Approximately 1,635 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

### **Access**

### **Scope and Content**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 78) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken August 8, 1994, through August 11, 1994. Numerous photo contact sheets from August 8 & 9, 1994, were previously processed in case 2021-0642-F.

The Clinton Presidential records to be opened consist of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, official phone calls, photo-ops, etc. involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

**Photographs from August 8, 1994, are as follows:**

**System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and

the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level.

While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
