Approximately 1,846 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 97) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken October 12, 1994, through October 14; October 16, 1994. Select photo contact sheets from October 14, 1994, were previously processed in case 2018-0084-F. The Finding Aid inventory will reflect the previously processed photo contact sheets.

The Clinton Presidential records to be opened consist of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, official phone calls, photo-ops, etc. involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Photographs from October 12, 1994, are as follows:

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton host a reception for Prime Minister Anibal Cavaco Silva and Maria Alves da Silva of Portugal at the White House. The Clintons and the Silvas gather in the Diplomatic Reception Room prior to the reception. The Clintons greet guests in the Blue Room. The residence and kitchen staff prepare various dishes for the reception.

President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Prime Minister Anibal Cavaco Silva of Portugal. Meeting participants include Elizabeth Bagley, Strobe Talbott, Tony Lake, and others. Prior to the meeting with the Prime Minister the President participates in a briefing in the Oval Office.

President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Sandy Berger and Leon Panetta.

President Clinton addresses a Michigan Day event in the East Room. President Clinton greets guests individually in the Blue Room. The President visits with Governor Jim Blanchard, his wife Janet Blanchard, and Marsha Scott in the Blue Room.

President Clinton attends and addresses the National Association of Police Organizations (NAPO) Dinner at the Capital Hilton Hotel in Washington, D.C. The President joins 12 "Top Cops" for a group photo at the event. President Clinton is presented with a jacket at the ceremony that reads "America's Top Cop."
