Scope and Content

FOIA request 2025-1081-F is a request for all Presidential series photographs regarding for photographs concerning a Native American Tribe Celebration event from 1995. On December 19, 1995, the Nottawaseppi Huron Band of Potawatomi Indians celebrated the Federal Government recognition of their tribe. The event took place in the Indian Treaty Room of the Old Executive Office Building (OEOB). Administration staff including Melanne Verveer and Loretta Avent were present at the meeting and celebration with the American Indian tribe. Native Americans perform traditional music and rituals during the celebration.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and

the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
