Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 16) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment were created from February 18, 1994 through February 22, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff and others for the time period processed.

Photographs from February 18, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton greets campaign staff in the East Room of the White House.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton departs Andrews Air Force Base en route Sioux Falls, South Dakota. The First Lady arrives at the South Dakota National Guard Terminal. The First Lady greets Governor Walter Dean Miller, Pat Miller, Senator Thomas Daschle, and Pat Halley. Also present is Secretary of Agriculture Mike Espy.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at Lennox High School in Lennox, South Dakota. Present are Alan Rops (Principal), Robert Mayer (Superintendent), and Mayor Floyd Beach. The First Lady addresses students and faculty present. Following her remarks, the First Lady participates in a meet and greet. Present includes Senator Thomas Daschle and Secretary of Agriculture Mike Espy, among others. Following the meet and greet the First Lady proceeds to a room to deliver interviews. Interviewees include Kelli Eggers, Joyce Terveen, Bobbi Lower, and Sherry Kurtz. Also present is Ranit Schemlzer.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in the Northern Great Plains Summit on Rural Health Care at Lennox High School in Lennox, South Dakota. Present includes Senator Thomas Daschle, Cecelia Humphrey, John Thompson, Governor Walter Dean Miller, Senator Larry Pressler, Senator Kent Conrad, Senator Bob Kerrey, Senator Paul Wellston, Representative Earl Pomeroy, Representative David Minge, Representative Rod Grams, and Secretary of Agriculture Mike Espy.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton tours the Lennox Medical Center. Present includes Senator Thomas Daschle, Secretary of Agriculture Mike Espy, Dr. Larry Sittner, and Scott Rogers, among others.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton departs Sioux Falls, South Dakota. Present includes Senator Thomas Daschle.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visits the Lincoln Center at Stevens Point in Wausau, Wisconsin. Present includes Senator Russell Feingold, Representative David Obey, and Pat Spade. The First Lady participates in a meeting regarding health care.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets congressional staff at the Grand Theater in Wausau, Wisconsin. Following the event the First Lady departs Wausau, Wisconsin.

Billie Shaddix and Marilyn Jacanin are photographed in the White House Photograph Office.

Photographs from February 19, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton delivers his weekly radio address in the Oval Office of the White House. Following the address, the President greets guests present. Present includes Secretary of State Warren Christopher, General John Shalikashvili, Mack McLarty, Jenonne Walker, David Gergen, Dee Dee Myers, Tony Lake, Mark Gearan, Helen Thomas, Andrea Mitchell, and Richard Strauss, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton prepares for his weekly radio address and televised statement to the nation regarding Bosnia. Present includes Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Secretary of Defense William Perry, General John Shalikashvili, Tony Lake, Mack McLarty, David Gergen, Don Steinberg, Mark Gearan, Dee Dee Myers, Jeremy Rosner, George Stephanopoulos, and Jenonne Walker.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visits the Community Care for the Elderly Center in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The First Lady delivers remarks on health care. Also present is Representative Thomas

Barrett, among others. The First Lady meet with the Health Care Reform Advisory Board. Also present is Representative Gerald Keczka.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at Alverno College. The First Lady delivers a speech on health care. Present includes Sister Joel Reed and Representative Gerald Keczka. The First Lady greets individuals present including Mike Jansen. Following the event, the First Lady departs Milwaukee en route Janesville. Present includes Melanne Verveer, Michael Verveer, Senator Russell Feingold and Mary Feingold.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at Rock County Airport in Janesville, Wisconsin. The First Lady greets Kathleen Barca and others present. The First Lady delivers a speech on health care at Blackhawk Technical College. Present includes Senator Russell Feingold and Representative Peter Barca, among others. Following the speech, the First Lady greets people present at a reception.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets people on the tarmac at Rock County Airport in Janesville, Wisconsin. The First Lady departs Janesville en route Andrews Air Force Base.

Photographs from February 20, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Chelsea Clinton depart the White House en route church services at Episcopal Church of Georgetown. Also present is Tommy Caplan. Upon return, the President converses with Helen Thomas and Mark Gearan.

President William Jefferson Clinton converses on the telephone in his study with Russian President Boris Yeltsin. Present as well includes Tony Lake and Nancy Soderberg. Later the President converses on the telephone in the Oval Office regarding Bosnia. Present includes Mack McLarty, Tony Lake, Sandy Berger, Mark Gearan, Don Steinberg, Nancy Soderberg, and Jenonne Walker..

Photographs from February 21, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a meeting in the Oval Office on Bosnia. Present includes Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Secretary of Defense William Perry, General John Shalikashvili, Tony Lake, David Gergen, Mack McLarty, Sandy Berger, Dee Dee Myers, and Don Steinberg.

Later the President delivers remarks in a press conference on Bosnia.

Photographs from February 22, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton jogs on The Mall in Washington, DC. The President returns to the White House where he poses for photographs on the Colonnade and in the Oval Office.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a meeting regarding Japan in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present at the meeting includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Secretary of Commerce Rom Brown, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Bob Rubin, Alan Binder, Robert Altman, Mickey Kantor, Laura Tyson, Sandy Berger, and Bowman Cutter, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in an Executive Order signing ceremony for Hispanic excellence in education in Room 450 of the Old Executive Office Building. Present at the signing includes Secretary of Education Richard Riley, Secretary of Transportation Federico Pena, and Secretary of Housing and Urban Development Henry Cisneros, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton delivers a statement to the press outside the Oval Office of the White House regarding CIA employee Aldrich Ames. Present includes Tony Lake, Mark Gearan, and Dee Dee Myers.

President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at the Washington Hilton Hotel in Washington, DC. The President addresses the American Council on Education event. Present includes Robert Atwell (President; American Council on Education), Father Edward Malloy (President; University of Notre Dame), Juliet Garcia (President; University of Texas at Brownsville), and Secretary of Education Richard Riley, among others.

Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with staff regarding health care in the Roosevelt Room of the White House. Present includes Secretary of Housing and Urban Development Henry Cisneros, Secretary of Transportation Federico Pena, Secretary of Agriculture Mike Espy, Secretary of the Interior Bruce Babbitt Secretary of Health and Human Services Donna Shalala, Harold Ickes, Lee Brown, Pat Griffin, Mandy Grunwald, Ira Magaziner, Stan Greenberg.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
