Extent

Approximately 2,607 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 24) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment were created from March 16, 1994 through March 19, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff and others for the time period processed.

Photographs from March 16, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a Senate Budget Committee meeting in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present includes Vice President Al Gore, Jr., Leon Panetta, Senator Paul Simon, Senator Paul Sarbanes, Senator Jim Sasser, Senator Christopher Dodd, Senator Frank

Lautenberg, Senator Barbara Boxer, Senator Patty Murray, Thomas “Mack” McLarty, Robert Rubin, David Gergen, George Stephanopoulos, Pat Griffin, Steve Ricchetti, and Susan Brophy.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with officers of the National League of Cities. Present include Loretta Avent and Marcia Hale.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets CIA Director James Woolsey and Chief Scout Executive of the Boy Scouts of America Jere Radcliffe in the Oval Office of the White House. The President is presented with the Boy Scouts report to the nation.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin at the White House. The Prime Minister signs the guest book, and proceeds to the Oval Office. The President and Prime Minister participate in a meeting. Following the meeting the President and Prime Minister proceed along the Colonnade to the Red Room for a press briefing. Photographed includes Vice President Al Gore, Jr., Molly Raiser, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Tony Lake, Samuel “Sandy” Berger, Edward Djerejian, and Dennis Ross, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in an interview with Peter Jennings of ABC at the White House. Preceding and following the interview the President greets Sam Braxton and Donna McLarty in separate instances.

Photographs from March 17, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses an Ad Council event to unveil a series of public announcements asking for help fighting youth violence. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Phil Geier, Jack Calhoun, Janet Reno and Alicia Brown, among others. Also photographed prior to the event includes David Dreyer and Andrew Friendly. Photographed following the event includes Jonathan Price, Mark Grobmyer, and Alexis Herman, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Irish Prime Minister Albert Reynolds at the White House. Present includes Vice President Al Gore, Jr., Ambassador Jean Kennedy Smith, and Tony Lake. Also photographed includes Andrew Friendly, Josh King, Nancy Soderberg, and Betty Currie. Later the President receives a crystal bowl of shamrocks from the Prime Minister. Following the event the President and Prime Minister return to the Oval Office, and speak with Nancy Soderberg, Mark Gearan, and Carter Wilkie.

President William Jefferson Clinton and Irish Prime Minister Albert Reynolds depart the White House en route Capitol Hill for a Saint Patrick’s Day luncheon event. Photographed includes Vice President Al Gore, Jr., Senator Ted Kennedy, Senator George Mitchell, Representative Tom Foley, Representative Dan Hamburg, Representative Kweisi Mfume, Representative Barbara Kennelly, Senator Christopher Dodd, Representative Patrick Schroeder, Representative Joe Kennedy, and Senator Thad Cochran, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Vice President Al Gore, Jr., George Stephanopoulos, Rahm Emanuel, David Dreyer, Thomas “Mack” McLarty, Jeff Eller, Jonathan Price, Jodie Greenstone, Nancy Hrenreich, and Andrew Friendly. Later the President signs an Earthquake Relief bill. Senator Barbara Boxer is present.

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on the telephone with President Hosni Mubarak of Egypt. Also present is Martin Indyk and Nancy Soderberg.

President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Al Gore, Jr., meet with television and cable network presidents in the Old Executive Office Building. Following the meeting the President and Vice President meet with Pat Griffin, Senator Daniel Patrick Moynihan, and Senator George Mitchell. The President and Vice President also converse with Tony Lake on the way back to the Oval Office to meet with Griffin and Ira Magaziner.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a photo shoot and interview with USA Weekend at the White House. Present include Andrew Ecclea, Amy Eishman, and Marsha Bullard.

President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton host a reception at the White House for Prime Minister Albert Reynolds and Mrs. Kathleen Coen Reynolds. Prior to the reception the President converses with Carter Wilkie. Also present includes Vice President Al Gore, Jr., Elizabeth "Tipper" Gore, Ambassador Jean Kennedy Smith, John Hume, Ethel Kennedy, Representative Tom Foley, Susan Brophy, Brian Lamb, Paul Newman, Conan O'Brian, Anjelica Houston, Joanne Woodward, Senator Christopher Dodd, Liz Robbins, Michael Keaton, Courteney Cox, Martha Stewart, Jim Reed, and Molly Raiser, among others.

Photographs from March 18, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Al Gore, Jr., participate in separate meetings in the Oval Office with President Alija Izetbegovic of Bosnia and President Fanjo Tudjman of Croatia. Also present include Secretary of State Warren Christopher and Tony Lake.

President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Al Gore, Jr., meet with President Alija Izetbegovic of Bosnia and President Fanjo Tudjman of Croatia in the Old Executive Office Building.

President William Jefferson Clinton confers with Vice President Al Gore, Jr., Tony Lake, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, George Stephanopoulos, Jenonne Walker, Jeremy Rosner in the Oval Office prior to the Bosnian-Croatian peace signing event. The President proceeds to the signing ceremony at the Old Executive Office Building. President William Jefferson Clinton has a briefing in the Oval Office Dining Room with Bob Boorstin, David Dreyer, George Stephanopoulos, Ricki Seidman, and John Hart, among others. The President proceeds to a roundtable discussion on health care with reporters and photographers.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets Sean Susseman and his family at the White House. Also present are Robyn Dickey and Andrew Friendly.

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on the telephone in the Oval Office with President Hafiz Asad of Syria.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with job corps representatives in the Oval Office of the White House. Present include Crystal Beck, Alfred Blue, and Sean Scope.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets Kathy Berlin and Kimberly Berlin.

President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participate in a taping session for the "Harry & Louise" health care message to play at the Gridiron dinner. Photographed includes Al Franken, Mandy Grunwald, Capricia Marshall, and Jeff Tuchman.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton discusses health care with regional press from Kansas, Oklahoma, and Nebraska at the White House. Also present includes Secretary of Health & Human Services Donna Shalala and Joann Anderson.

Billie Shaddix presents a ten-year service pin and certificate to Marilyn Jacanin. Present are Bob McNeely, Brad Smith, and Janet Philips.

Photographs from March 19, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton stops by the East Room of the White House to prepare for the ABC Kids' Town Hall Meeting. The President departs and proceeds to the Oval Office. The President delivers his weekly radio address in the Oval Office.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
