Approximately 2,479 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0985-F (Segment 3) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1995 through December 31, 1995.

The photographs processed in this segment were created on January 10, 1995 through January 12, 1995. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Select images were previously processed in FOIA case # 2009-1398-F.

Photographs from January 10, 1995 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Senator Chris Dodd, Robert Rubin, and Judith Rubin in the Oval Office of the White House. Robert Rubin is sworn in as Secretary of the Treasury. Present at the event include Harold Ickes, Leon Panetta, Laura Tyson, Gene Sperling, Todd Stern, Susan Brophy, Vicki Radd, and Erskine Bowles, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with economic advisers in the Oval Office of the White House regarding the decline of the value of the Peso. Present includes Secretary of the Treasury Robert Rubin, Larry Summers, Laura Tyson, Frank Newman, Erskine Bowles, Leon Panetta, Pat Griffin, and George Stephanopoulos.

President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Quad Cities International Airport in Moline, Illinois. The President greets guests present and waves to the crowd. Photographed is Andrew Friendly. The President departs en route Carl Sandberg College in Galesburg, Illinois. The President arrives at Carl Sandberg College and participates in a roundtable discussion in the library of the college regarding the Middle Class Bill of Rights. Later the President addresses students and guest in the gymnasium. Present includes Secretary of Education Richard Riley, Secretary of Labor Robert Reich, and Don Crist (President; Carl Sandberg College). Following the event the President greets guests. Also photographed includes Harold Ickes, Phil Caplan, Kirk Hanlin, and Dave Carpenter, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses the community of Galesburg, Illinois, in the Galesburg High School gymnasium.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests at Quad Cities International Airport in Moline, Illinois prior to departing for Andrews Air Force Base. The President disembarks Air Force One at Andrews and embarks on Marine One en route the White House. Later the President is photographed walking into the Diplomatic Reception Room foyer upon his return to the White House.

Photographs from January 11, 1995 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton jogs around the White House, with the South Portico visible in the background. Also included are photographs of the Washington Monument.

President William Jefferson Clinton stands behind the Resolute Desk in the Oval Office of the White House and tapes a message. Richard Strauss is present. Later the President speaks with Leon Panetta, Michael McCurry, Steve Silverman, and Harold Ickes.

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Secretary of Labor Robert Reich, Harold Ickes, and Leon Panetta in the Outer Oval Office of the White House. Also photographed is both George Stephanopoulos and Thomas "Mack" McLarty on the telephone.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Oval Office of the White House regarding the upcoming visit of Prime Minister Tomiichi Murayama (村山 富市) of Japan. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Ambassador to Japan Walter Mondale, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, Bowman Cutter, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Secretary of the Treasury Robert Rubin, Mickey Kantor, and Leon Panetta. Prime Minister Murayama signs the guest book in the Roosevelt Room. Photographed is Molly Raiser. President Clinton proceeds to the Cabinet Room and greets Prime Minister Murayama.

Present from the previous meeting includes Vice President Gore, Secretary Christopher, Ambassador Mondale, Kantor, Cutter, and joining them includes Admiral William Owens, John Deutch, and Laura Tyson. The President and Prime Minister are photographed walking along the Colonnade to the State Dining Room. The President speaks with McCurry, Vice President Gore, Secretary Christopher, Kantor, and Ambassador Mondale in the Red Room. The President and Prime Minister deliver statements to the press in the Grand Foyer. The Prime Minister is presented with a basket of apples. Later, Prime Minister Murayama departs via South Portico.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets members of the Arkansas Bar Association in the Oval Office of the White House, including Niki Cung, Jim Branton, Harold Daniel, Scott Welch, William Blews, David Jones, and Robert Jones.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a satellite feed at the White House to Los Angeles, California. The President speaks with John Emerson, Tom Epstein, and Steve Silverman. Following the remarks the President speaks with Harold Ickes, Susan Thomases, and Leon Panetta, and later Don Fowler separately.

Miscellaneous photographs include the Resolute Desk in the Oval Office showing President William Jefferson Clinton's memorabilia including the President's challenge coin collection, personal photographs, books, stationary, and a model of a Ford Mustang convertible, among other items.

Photographs from January 12, 1995 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Cabinet Room of the White House with incoming members of Congress. Present includes Representative Patrick Kennedy, Representative William Luther, Representative Sheila Jackson Lee, Representative Karen McCarthy, Erskine Bowles, and George Stephanopoulos.

President William Jefferson Clinton attends a South-Central Communications (SCC) telecommunications meeting in the Indian Treaty Room of the Old Executive Office Building. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr. Following the meeting the President stops by the Vice President's office.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Oval Office of the White House with James Lee Witt, Leon Panetta, John Emerson, and Steve Silverman. The President jokes with Betty Currie in the Outer Oval Office.

President William Jefferson Clinton attends a scheduling meeting in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present includes Billy Webster, Leon Panetta, Mark Gearan, Stephanie Streett, Nancy HERNREICH, and Anne Walley. Following the meeting the President converses with Walley, Webster, and Streett in the West Wing. The President greets First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton and Dee Dee Myers.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Oval Office of the White House with Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Samuel "Sandy" Berger, and Leon Fuerth. The President and Berger walk along the Colonnade to a luncheon with retired military service members. The President greets retiring military service members in the State Dining Room of the White House. Present includes the Vice President and Leon Panetta.

President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets guests at the Kennedy Center in Washington, DC, prior to a performance of “Tommy.” Also photographed is the Clintons returning to the White House.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a meeting in the Cabinet Room of the White House regarding the value of the Mexican Peso. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Representative Richard Gephardt, Representative Newt Gingrich, Senator Robert Dole, Senator Tom Daschle, Laura Tyson, Secretary of the Treasury Robert Rubin, Leon Panetta, Alan Greenspan, Samuel “Sandy” Berger, Thomas “Mack” McLarty, and Bowman Cutter.

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on the telephone in the Oval Office to President Ernesto Zedillo of Mexico about the United States’ response to the falling value of the Mexican Peso. Present includes Jim Reed, Leon Panetta, and Samuel “Sandy” Berger.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Yellow Oval Room of the White House with Representative Ron Dellums, Representative Dick Armey, Representative Charles Rangel, Representative George Miller, Pat Griffin, and Leon Panetta.

President William Jefferson Clinton holds a meeting in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present includes Roy Spence, Mark Gearan, and Erskine Bowles, among others. Following the meeting the President greets Kenneth “Baby Face” Brian Edmonds and his entourage in the Oval Office.

Miscellaneous images include White House photographers Sharon Farmer and Callie Shell posing on the Colonnade of the White House.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
