Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 41) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken April 29, 1994, through May 3, 1994. Several photo contact sheets in this segment were previously processed in case 2023-0675-F. The Finding Aid inventory will reflect the previously processed photo contact sheets.

The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Photographs from April 29, 1994, are as follows:

President Clinton attends a luncheon in the Roosevelt Room with Corporate Executive Officers including Howard Schultz, CEO, Starbuck's Coffee. Vice President Albert Gore, Laura Tyson, Roger Altman, Alexis Herman, and Robert Rubin are present at the lunch. Views of the Roosevelt Room table settings for the luncheon.

President Clinton participates in a briefing on health care in the Oval Office. The President meets with Vice President Albert Gore, Susan Brophy, George Stephanopoulos, Jeff Eller, Nancy Hernreich, and Stephen Goodin.

President Clinton and Howard Schultz, CEO, Starbuck's address regional media regarding health care in the Roosevelt Room.

President Clinton talks with Harold Ickes on the White House Colonnade. President Clinton walks alone towards the Oval Office.

President Clinton greets Bell Atlantic workers in the Oval Office.

President Clinton addresses an Assault Weapons event in Room 450 of the Old Executive Office Building (OEOB). Participants include Secretary Lloyd Bentsen, John Magaw, Director of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms (ATF), David Steingraber, Police Chief. Director Magaw shows the President a display of weapons. Press photographers take photos of the guns on display and event visual aids of newspaper headlines. President Clinton greets event participants in the OEOB.

President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Sheila Jackson Lee and Joan Baggett.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets in the Diplomatic Reception Room with Kansas State Opinion Leaders. Alexis Herman introduces the First Lady at the meeting.

President Clinton meets alone with President Carter in the study at the Carter Center. President Clinton greets Carter Center staff. President Clinton and President Carter talk with George Stephanopoulos, Wendy Smith, and Stephen Goodin at the Carter Center.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
