Approximately 2,512 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 96) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment were created on October 10, 1994 through October 12, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Photographs from October 10, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton works with senior staff on his address to Haiti & regarding the situation in Iraq in the Oval Office, Outer Oval Office, and Oval Office Mess. Present includes Secretary of Defense William Perry, General John Shalikashvili, and Tony Lake. Also photographed are Harold Ickes, David Gergen, George Stephanopoulos, Betty Currie, Leon Panetta, Mark Gearan, Samuel “Sandy” Berger, and Rahm Emanuel. Jim Reed sets up a telephone call at the Resolute Desk and the President speaks on the telephone. Martin Indyk joins the President. Later the President delivers an address to the nation regarding policy towards both Haiti & situation in Iraq. The President prior to the address is photographed in a pool spray and following the address greets television crew present.

President William Jefferson Clinton jokes with staff members in the Outer Oval Office of the White House. Photographed includes Betty Currie, Debi Schiff, Kelly Crawford, Rahm Emanuel, and Wendy Smith.

George Stephanopoulos is photographed with bubble gum.

Photographs from October 11, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton jogs in Washington, DC.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Oval Office of the White House with Tony Lake, Leon Panetta, Samuel “Sandy” Berger, and Leon Fuerth.

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks to reporters on the South Lawn of the White House prior to departing for Ypsilanti, Michigan. The President is accompanied by Tony Lake. Also photographed is Socks the Cat.

President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Willow Run Airport in Ypsilanti, Michigan. The President on disembarking Air Force One greets Senator Don Riegle, Senator Carl Levin, and Gene Sperling, among others. The President proceeds to the Ford Motor Company’s Dearborn Assembly Plant in Dearborn, Michigan and tours the SN95 Ford Mustang assembly line and quality control center. The President observes finished Mustangs on the assembly line and sits inside of an SN95 GT convertible. Present is Chuck Matland and Ernie Lofton. Later the President address assembly line employees and other employees of Ford Motor Company at an event outside. Present includes Alexander Trotman (Chief Executive Officer; Ford Motor Company) and Owen Bieber (President; United Auto Workers).

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with executives from “The Big Three” American automobile manufacturers at the Westin Hotel in Detroit, Michigan. Present includes John F. Smith, Jr., Alexander Trotman, and Lee Iacocca. Also present is Owen Bieber and United Auto Workers leaders. The President addresses attendees at the hotel.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with the editorial board of The Detroit Free Press at their offices in Detroit, Michigan. The President greets employees present, is presented with a cartoon, and poses with a life-size cut-out of First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton.

President William Jefferson Clinton shops at Borders Bookstore in the Renaissance Center in Detroit, Michigan. Also photographed is the President inside a RadioShack.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests at Willow Run Airport in Ypsilanti, Michigan prior to departure. Also photographed is various shots of Air Force One and Military Aide Rusty Schorsch.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attends a book signing by Liz Carpenter at Borders Bookstore in Washington, DC. Also present is Paula Stout.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses a sculpture garden event in the Jacqueline Kennedy Garden at the White House. Prior to the event the First Lady greets guests in the Blue Room. Also photographed are White House butler staff.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets guests at a Franklin Delano Roosevelt reception in the Blue Room of the White House. Present include Senator Carl Levin, Senator Daniel Inouye, and Representative Patsy Mink, among others. Later the First Lady greets John Podesta and Paul Richard.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton is presented with an anniversary gift from the First Lady's staff in the Map Room of the White House. Later the First Lady greets John Podesta and Paul Richard

Photographs from October 12, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses a police grants ceremony on the South Lawn of the White House. Present includes Attorney General Janet Reno, Police Chief David Massey (Ocean City, Maryland), and various police officers from Baltimore and Ocean City, Maryland. Prior to the event the President greets guests in the Diplomatic Reception Room. The President converses with Senator Paul Sarbanes. Later the President is photographed walking towards the West Wing with Wendy Smith and Marcia Hale.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Samuel "Sandy" Berger and Leon Panetta in the Oval Office of the White House. Later the President speaks on the telephone with President Itamar Franco of Brazil. The President also signs various legislation presented to him on the Resolute desk.

President William Jefferson Clinton drops by an event with members of the Franklin Delano Roosevelt Commission in the Roosevelt Room of the White House. The President poses for a group shot with attendees in the Oval Office.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Prime Minister Anibal Cavaco Silva of Portugal in the Oval Office of the White House. Present includes Elizabeth Bagley, Strobe Talbott, and Tony Lake, among others. The President participates in a briefing prior to the meeting.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in an economic meeting in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present includes Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown, Secretary of Labor Robert Reich, Bowman Cutter, Jack Quinn, Alice Rivlin, Joseph Stiglitz, Pat Griffin, Gene Sperling, and Robert Rubin, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a meeting the Oval Office of the White House. Present includes Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Laura Tyson, Alice Rivlin, and Leon Panetta. The President converses with Bentsen, Rivlin, and Tyson in the Outer Oval Office. Also photographed is Tony Lake prior to the meeting.

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with Leon Panetta, Rahm Emanuel, Jonathan Prince, Bruce Reed, George Stephanopoulos, and Stephen Goodin in the Oval Office of the White House. The President and Panetta walk along the Colonnade.

President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton host a reception at the White House for Prime Minister Anibal Cavaco Silva and Mrs. Maria Cavaco Silva of Portugal. The President and Prime Minister proceed along the Colonnade to the Diplomatic Reception Room, greet guests in the Blue Room, and give an address in the East Room. Following the events Prime Minister Cavaco Silva and Mrs. Cavaco Silva depart via the South Portico.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton is photographed greeting guests at the White House. Photographed includes Vera Lawrence, Representative Sam Coppersmith, (Lord) Roy Jenkins, (Lady) Mary Jennifer Jenkins, Kaitlyn Thomas, and Kevin Phillips.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
