Extent

Approximately 2,474 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 98) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment were created on October 14, 1994 through October 17, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Photographs from October 14, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Bob Boorstin and Don Steinberg in the Oval Office of the White House. Later the President meets with Joan Baggett, Tony Coelho, Harold Ickes, and Leon Panetta. Also present is Margaret Jane “Dee Dee” Myers who sits next to the Resolute desk.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Joan Baggett, Tony Coelho, Harold Ickes, and Leon Panetta in the Oval Office of the White House.

President William Jefferson Clinton delivers his weekly radio address in the Roosevelt Room of the White House. Following the address the President greets guests in the Oval Office. Photographed includes Secretary of Labor Robert Reich, Margaret Jane “Dee Dee” Myers, and Bruce Lindsey, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton drops by an event in the Roosevelt Room of the White House of Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown swearing in Christine Varney as member of the Federal Elections Committee.

President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton host the Arts and Humanities award dinner on the State Floor of the White House. The President and First Lady greet guests in the Grand Foyer as they arrive. Entertainment is provided by Yitzhak Perlman in the East Room. Also photographed are guests dancing, including Secretary of Education Richard Riley and Harry Belafonte.

Photographs from October 15, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton goes jogging around the White House vicinity in Washington, DC. Present are Beth Coulson, Michael Coulson, Guy Wade, and Carole Wade. Following the morning jog the President converses with First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Leon Panetta, and Harold Ickes.

President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton depart the White House via Marine One en route Andrews Air Force Base. The President and First Lady depart on Air Force One en route Hartford and Bridgeport, Connecticut. The President and First Lady disembark Air Force One at Bradley Air National Guard Base at Bradley International Airport in Windsor Locks, Connecticut. The President and First Lady attend an event in Bridgeport, Connecticut.

President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton travel aboard Air Force One en route Miami, Florida. The President and First Lady disembark at Miami International Airport in Miami, Florida. Photographed includes Mort Engelberg and Marsha Scott. The President and First Lady proceed to an event at the port in Miami, Florida.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in an interview with the Miami Herald in Miami, Florida.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests and police at Miami International Airport in Miami, Florida prior to departure. Also photographed is Marsha Scott.

Photographs from October 16, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with Vice President Albert Gore, Jr. and George Stephanopoulos in the Outer Oval Office of the White House. Also photographed is Nancy Hernreich on the telephone and Stephanie Streett.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Oval Office of the White House with Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., General John Saakashvili, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Ambassador Madeleine Albright, John Deutch, Tony Lake, Leon Panetta, and Larry Bossin.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with advisors regarding Haiti. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Secretary of State Warren Christopher, John Deutch, Leon Panetta, Ambassador Madeleine Albright, George Stephanopoulos, Tony Lake, General John Shalikashvili, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, Leon Fuerth, Brian Atwood, Larry Bossin, Margaret Jane "Dee Dee" Myers, David Gergen, and William Gray, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton delivers remarks regarding Haiti on the North Driveway of the White House. Present includes Representative Joe Kennedy, George Stephanopoulos, Nancy Hernreich, Stephen Goodin, and Josh King. Prior to the event the President reviews his statement with Goodin in the West Wing Lobby.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton departs Miami, Florida en route Andrews Air Force Base. The First Lady arrives at Andrews Air Force Base.

Photographs from October 17, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Leon Panetta, Tony Lake, Martin Indyk, and Margaret Jane "Dee Dee" Myers in the Oval Office of the White House. The President walks down the South Lawn and picks up Socks the Cat. The President proceeds to Marine One and is photographed with Bruce Lindsey, Will Itoh, and Myers. Upon arrival at Andrews Air Force Base the President delivers a statement on the tarmac. The President boards Air Force One. On the flight the President makes a telephone call to Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin of Israel and King Hussein bin Talal of Jordan. The President converses with staff including Stephen Goodin, Wendy Smith, Marsha Scott, and crew.

President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at Kirtland Air Force Base in New Mexico. The President greets guests on the tarmac including Governor Bruce King and American Indian Governors.

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses the International Association of Chiefs & Police at the Albuquerque Convention Center in New Mexico. Photographed includes Sylvester Daughtery (President, IACP), Dr. Lee Brown, Senator Jeff Bingaman, and Representative Bill Richardson. Following the event the President and Governor Bruce King greets guests & police officers both inside and outside the Convention Center.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests on the tarmac at Kirtland Air Force Base prior to departure. Also photographed is staff aboard Air Force One including Dr. Lee Brown and Air Force One on the tarmac upon arrival at Andrews Air Force Base.

Miscellaneous photographs include John York, Molly McNeely, Craig Livingstone, Attorney General Janet Reno, Debi Schiff, Mike Shearas, Doriana Allyn Carolyn Thompson, and Socks the Cat at the White House.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
