Approximately 2,431 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

#### **Scope and Content**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 12) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 15, 1994 & February 8, 1994, through February 12, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

**System of Arrangement**
