Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 77) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment were created on August 3, 1994 through August 6, 1994 and August 8, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Select material responsive to this segment was previously processed in FOIA case # 2015-0709-F.

Photographs from August 3, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with staff in the Oval Office Dining Room at the White House. Present at the meeting includes Mandy Grunwald, George Stephanopoulos, Stan Greenberg, and Harold Ickes.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with staff in the Family Theatre of the White House regarding an upcoming press conference. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Don Baer, Mark Gearan, Mandy Grunwald, Paul Begala, Gene Sperling, Leon Panetta, Dee Dee Myers, and David Breyer. The President is also photographed in the Map Room and Blue Room. Joining the President in the Blue Room is Phil Lader. The President also meets in the Cabinet Room with staff. Present from the previous meeting includes the First Lady, Stephanopoulos, Lader, Sperling, Gearan, and joining the meeting includes Michael Waldman, Laura Tyson, Lloyd Cutler, David Gergen, and Tony Lake. The President is also photographed in Cross Hall and the Residence.

Various staff events are photographed at the White House. They include Robert Rubin greeting departing staff members in the West Wing, Leon Panetta & Ira Magaziner meeting with health care reform coalition leaders in the Roosevelt Room, Graham Nash in the Diplomatic Reception Room, and National Park Service employees posing on the South Lawn & Truman Balcony stairs.

Photographs from August 4, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton greets Senator Max Baucus in the Oval Office of the White House.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with advisers in the Oval Office Dining Room of the White House prior to taping health care related messages. Present includes Mandy Grunwald, Stan Greenberg, Christine Heenan, Meeghan Prunty, Lillian Brown, Leon Panetta, Steve Ricchetti, and Chris Jennings.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with senior cabinet staff in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Secretary of Defense William Perry, Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown, Secretary of Transportation Federico Pena, Carol Browner, Laura Tyson, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Secretary of Health & Human Services Donna Shalala, Secretary of Education Richard Riley, Ambassador Madeleine Albright, Lee Brown, Alice Rivlin, Mickey Kantor, Secretary of Energy Hazel O'Leary, Secretary of Labor Robert Reich, Attorney General Janet Reno, Secretary of Agriculture Mike Espy, Chief of Staff Leon Panetta, Phil Caplan, Joan Baggett, Christine Varney, Pat Griffin, Tony Lake, Carol Rasco.

Also photographed is Brian Rock (Socks the Cat's assistant).

Photographs from August 5, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton tapes his weekly radio address in the Roosevelt Room of the White House. Following the taping the President greets guests in the Oval Office.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with staff in the Oval Office Dining Room of the White House regarding taping sessions for health care. Present includes Mandy Grunwald, Stan Greenberg, Christine Heenan, Meeghan Prunty, Tony Lake, Jonathan Prince, Alan Stone, and Don Baer, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets Senator John Breaux in the Oval Office of the White House. Later the President meets with Leon Panetta in the Oval Office. Also photographed is Betty Currie, whom with the President looks at documents on Mrs. Currie's desk in the Outer Oval Office.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with staff in the Oval Office of the White House regarding an upcoming speech for the anniversary of passing the economic plan. Present includes Vice President Al Gore, Jr., George Stephanopoulos, Jonathan Prince, Rahm Emanuel, David Kusnet, Josh King, Robert Rubin, Don Baer, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Mark Gearan, and Gene Sperling. The President and Vice President proceed to an event in the Room 450 of the Old Executive Office Building to recognize the anniversary of the passing of the economic plan (The event was to take place in the Rose Garden, but moved due to rain.). Present includes Robert Eaton, Frankie McLaurin, Carol Bartz, and James Quimby, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with foreign policy staff in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Leon Panetta, Robert Rubin, Tony Lake, Alice Rivlin, David Gergen, Secretary of Defense William Perry, George Stephanopoulos, James Woolsey, Leon Fuerth, Joel Klein, and Ambassador Madeleine Albright, among others.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in an interview in the Map Room of the White House with Marian Burros. Also present is Lisa Caputo.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in an interview with Peter Maer for Mutual Broadcast Radio. Also present is Lisa Caputo. The First Lady speaks with Maggie Williams, Melanne Verveer, Diane Limo, and Caputo. Afterwards the First Lady greets White House Correspondence Office volunteers and interns.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton Participates in a HealthRight event at the Longworth Building on Capitol Hill. Present includes Arthur Flemming, Representative Mary Rose Oakar, Representative Sam Gibbons, Representative Kweisi Mfume, Representative Dan Rostenkowski, and Representative Ron Wyden, among others. Also photographed is the First Lady departing the White House en route Capitol Hill. Present includes Melanne Verveer and Gary Walters.

President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Chelsea Clinton walk to Marine One on the South Lawn Landing Zone. Marine One departs en route Camp David.

Photographs from August 6, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton arrives via Marine One at Andrews Air Force Base. The President departs for Detroit, Michigan. Aboard the flight the President confers with Senator Carl Levin, Representative John Conyers, and Representative John Dingell. Air Force One arrives at Selfridge Air National Guard Base in Michigan. The President disembarks and addresses guests on the tarmac. Also photographed are Representative Dingell & Representative John Conyers, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton attends a “Michigan Salutes the President” event at the Westin Hotel in Detroit, Michigan. Also photographed is Kirk Hanlin and hotel greeters. Following the event the President addresses a reception in the Renaissance Ballroom. Present include Senator Don Riegel & Senator Carl Levin, among others. President William Jefferson Clinton greets guests on the tarmac at Selfridge Air National Guard Base. The President departs Michigan via Air Force One en route Andrews Air Force Base. Photographed includes Jim Reed, Bruce Lindsey, and Jeff Eller, among others.

Photographs from August 8, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Chelsea Clinton disembark Marine One on the South Lawn of the White House on return from Camp David.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Oval Office of the White House with George Stephanopoulos, Steve Ricchetti, Pat Griffin, and Jack Lew. Later the President confers with Carol Rasco & Stephanopoulos.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a meeting regarding the Crime Bill in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present includes Secretary of Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Attorney General Janet Reno, and members of the law enforcement steering committee. The President also meets with members of Congress, and following the meeting greets individual police officers. Prior to the meeting the President confers with George Stephanopoulos, Rahm Emanuel, Bruce Reed, Steve Hilton, and Ron Klain.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in various one-on-one interviews in Room 459 of the Old Executive Office Building. The interviewing stations include WABC New York, WCBS New York, WNBC New York, WPVI ABC Philadelphia, KYW NBC Philadelphia, KNBC Los Angeles, KCAL Los Angeles, KRON NBC San Francisco, and KGO ABC San Francisco.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
