Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 116) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment were created on December 6, 1994 through December 8, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Photographs from December 6, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Senator John Breaux, Senator Charles Robb, Senator Joseph Liberman, and Senator Sam Nunn, among others, in the Oval Office of the White House.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a budget briefing in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Robert Rubin, Secretary of Commerce Ronald Brown, Mark Gearan, Bowman Cutter, Joseph Stiglitz, Gene Sperling, Alice Rivlin, Secretary of Labor Robert Reich, Leon Panetta, Laura Tyson, William Galston, Erskine Bowles, and George Stephanopoulos. Prior to the meeting the President speaks with Billy Webster and Stephen Goodin in the Outer Oval Office. Following the meeting the President speaks with Bruce Lindsey and Bruce Reed in the hallway of the West Wing of the White House.

President William Jefferson Clinton announces Robert Rubin as replacement for Lloyd Bentsen as Secretary of the Treasury in an event in the Rose Garden of the White House. Prior to the event the President meets in the Oval Office with Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Leon Panetta, Beryl Ann Bentsen, Robert Rubin, Judith Rubin, Mark Gearan, George Stephanopoulos, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, and Secretary of Education Richard Riley. The President poses for a group shot.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with School-to-Work corporate executive officers in the Cabinet Room of the White House to discuss School-to-Work implementation. Present includes Alexander Trotman, Secretary of Labor Robert Reich, and Secretary of Education Richard Riley, among others. Prior to the meeting the President speaks with Alexis Herman and Steve Silverman in the Oval Office.

President William Jefferson Clinton is photographed with Socks the Cat on the White House putting green.

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with Roger Altman in the Old Executive Office Building hallway. The President proceeds to Room 459 to tape messages including a Holiday Message for Armed Forces, Christmas Special Holiday Messages for United States Organizations, White House Conference on Small Business, and a National Adoption PSA. Present includes Dave Anderson, Paul Meyer, and Stephen Goodin. The President hugs children participating in the adoption PSA. Following the tapings the President greets Native-American Indian leaders, Natalie Wozniak, and Ben Foncesbeck (White House Photographer) in the Old Executive Office Building hallway, and proceeds across West Executive Avenue.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton address a physical fitness event on the South Lawn of the White House. Present includes Dr. C. Everett Koop, Florence Griffith Joyner, and Tom McMillen, among others. Prior to the event the First Lady Greets Dr. Koop, Sandy Perlmutter, Al Joyner, and others.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attends an American Way event in Washington, DC. Photographed includes Melanne Vermeer and Norman Lear.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attends the Peace on Earth gala at the Capitol Hilton Hotel in Washington, DC. Present includes Betty Bumpers, Carol Williams, Saraah Ferguson (Duchess of York), Ambassador Li Daoyu (李道豫)(Chinese Ambassador to the United States), and Brooke Low.

Miscellaneous photographs include shots of the White House Photograph Office areas.

Photographs from December 7, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton jogs on the Mall in Washington, DC.

President William Jefferson Clinton plays golf at Army Navy Country Club in Virginia.

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on the telephone to Pearl Harbor survivors on the anniversary of the attack on Pearl Harbor. Following the conversation the President speaks with Vice President Albert Gore, Jr. Later the President greets Reverend Hezekiah D. Stewart and Diane Stewart.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a promotion ceremony in the Oval Office of the White House for Commander Eleanor C. "Connie" Mariano. The President greets Dr. Mariano and her family, along with White House medical unit staff.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a budget briefing in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Secretary of Commerce Ronald Brown, Robert Rubin, Laura Tyson, Alice Rivlin, Leon Panetta, Gene Sperling, and Joseph Stiglitz, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Anthony Lake, Bowman Cutter, Grace Garcia, Robert Boorstin, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, David Gergen, Erskine Bowles, Roger Altman, and George Stephanopoulos in the Oval Office of the White House. Later the President confers with Vice President Gore, Lake, and Leon Panetta in the Oval Office. The Vice President confers with Lake and Jack Quinn in the Outer Oval Office.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Enrique Inglesias (Inter-American Development Bank) and Ron Scheman (Inter-American Development Bank) in the West Wing of the White House. The First Lady proceeds to the Old Executive Office Building where she greets White House credit union personnel. The First Lady addresses a briefing for state directors in Room 450 of the OEOP. Photographed is Joan Baggett. Later the First Lady greets Jennifer Klein, and greets staff who handles the First Lady's correspondence in Room 17 of the OEOP.

President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Chelsea Clinton attend the annual Pageant of Peace tree lighting ceremony on the Ellipse in Washington, DC. Present includes Santa Claus, Aretha Franklin, Trisha Yearwood, John Betchkal (President; Pageant of Peace), Reverend Luis Leon, Nicholas Howard, Andrea Stuart, Richard Leech (Metropolitan Opera). The President & First Lady light the Christmas tree. Following the event the Clintons proceed to a reception in the Diplomatic Reception Room of the White House. The Clintons greet guests present including Thomas McKnight (designer of the 1994 White House Christmas card) and Renate McKnight, among others.

Miscellaneous photographs include Anthony Lake greeting departing National Security Council staff members in the West Wing of the White House, Socks the cat laying on a deer sculpture on the South Lawn, handicapped visitors accessing the White House via the East Wing disability ramp, and Santa Claus greeting children at a Christmas event during a tour of the White House.

Photographs from December 8, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton tapes his weekly radio address in the Oval Office of the White House. The President greets guests present including Secretary of Health & Human Services Donna Shalala. Following the address the President greets Paul Montrone and Sandra Montrone, whom present the President with a gift.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in an interview in the Oval Office dining room of the White House with Al Hunt (Wall Street Journal), among other individuals present. Following the interviews the President proceeds to the Roosevelt Room to participate in interviews with Telemundo and Univision.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Oval Office of the White House with Leon Panetta, Marcia Hale, Carol Rasco, and Bruce Reed. The President proceeds to a meeting with governors in the Cabinet Room. Present includes Governor Roy Romer, Governor Tom Carper, Governor John Engler, Bruce Lindsey, Laura Tyson, Rasco, and Hale.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with advisers at the White House for preparation for the Summit of the Americas. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Mickey Kantor, Anthony Lake, Bowman Cutter, Roger Altman, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, Leon Fuerth, David Gergen, and Robert Borstin, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton poses for a group photo opportunity with the White House interns on the South Lawn of the White House. Photographed is Karin Abramson, among others.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in an interview in the Diplomatic Reception Room of the White House with Peggy Lewis. Also photographed is Brian Rock & Socks the Cat.

President William Jefferson Clinton walks down the South Lawn sidewalk to the Presidential limousine. Present is Vice President Albert Gore, Jr. and Leon Panetta. They depart the White House en route the Organization of American States in Washington, DC. Upon arrival they are met by Ana O'Brien (Chief of Protocol; Organization of American States), Dr. Cesar Javiria (Secretary General; Organization of American States), Harriett Babbitt (United States Ambassador; Organization of American States), Assistant Secretary General Christopher Thomas and Odeen Ishma (Ambassador to Guyana. The President and Vice President address the ceremony, and President Clinton signs the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (GATT). Present includes Mickey Kantor, Senator Robert Dole, Representative Thomas Foley, Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Secretary of Commerce Ronald Brown, Carla Hills, Strobe Talbott, and Secretary of Agriculture Mike Espy.

President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton prepare to depart the White House. The First Lady bids farewell to Chelsea Clinton in the Ground Floor Residence. The President and First Lady depart the Diplomatic Reception Room and walk towards Marine One on the South Lawn landing zone. The Clinton depart via Air Force One en route Miami, Florida. Present includes Attorney General Janet Reno, Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Anthony Lake, Roger Altman, Robert Borstin, Bowman Cutter, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, Mickey Kantor, Patti Solis, Alexis Herman, Ann Stock, Josh King, Stephen Goodin, Andrew Friendly, and Erskine Bowles, among others. The President and First Lady attend an arrival ceremony event at the Sheraton Bal Harbour in Miami. Also present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Mary Elizabeth "Tipper" Gore, Governor Lawton Chiles, Rhea Chiles, Lieutenant Governor Buddy Mackay, and Senator Robert Graham, among others.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
