#### **Extent**

Approximately 2,618 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

#### **Access**

#### **Scope and Content**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 33) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken April 11, 1994, through April 13, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

President Clinton greets Bruce Thiesen, American Legion National Commander, and Representatives from the American Legion in the Oval Office.

President Clinton participates in a briefing in the Oval Office prior to his meeting with German Opposition Leader Rudolf Scharping.

President Clinton and Garrison Keillor address the dinner. Photos include tight shots of the President laughing during the dinner. Following the dinner President Clinton talks with Secretary Lloyd Bentsen in the hallway at the hotel. President Clinton talks with George Stephanopoulos, Dee Dee Myers, Mark Gearan, and Rick Seidman at the hotel. The Clintons greet Cokie Roberts, Senator Ernest Hollings, and others at the hotel. The Clintons return to the Ground Floor residence of the White House with Ricki Seidman and Mark Gearan.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton talks with Jan Piercy, Melanne Verveer, Marcia Hale, Dee Dee Myers, Mark Gearan, and George Stephanopoulos in the Outer Oval Office. President Clinton joins the group in the Outer Oval Office.
