Approximately 2,248 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0985-F (Segment 10) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1995, through December 31, 1995. The photographs processed in this segment were created on January 30, 1995; February 2, 1995, through February 4, 1995. Numerous photograph contact sheets from February 2, 1995, were previously processed in case 2018-0726-F. The Finding Aid inventory will reflect the previously processed photo contact sheets.

The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Photographs from January 30, 1995, are as follows:

President Clinton participates in the National Governors Association meeting in the East Room. The President talks with Governors individually at the meeting.

Photographs from February 2, 1995, are as follows:

President Clinton participates in an interview in the Oval Office with reporters from religious press organizations. Prior to the interview, the President participates in a briefing in the Oval Office with Mike McCurry, George Stephanopoulos, and Leon Panetta.

President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Michael Carns, Leon Panetta, and George Tenet.

Leon Panetta meets with Tom Hufford in the West Wing.

President Clinton announces Dr. Henry Foster, Jr. as his nominee for Surgeon General. Participants present in the Oval Office include St. Clair Anderson, Secretary Donna Shalala, Senator Bill Frist, Representative Bob Clement, and Dr. Phil Lee. The White House Press Pool covers the announcement. Prior to the announcement, President Clinton meets with Dr. Foster and others in the Oval Office Dining Room. In addition, President Clinton participates in a briefing in the Oval Office with Mike McCurry, George Stephanopoulos, Leon Panetta, Secretary Shalala, Don Baer, and Carolyn Curiel.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in the National Girls and Women in Sports Presentation of the Flo Hyman Award in the Diplomatic Reception Room of the White House.

The First Lady is presented a pin by Wendy Hillard, President of the Women's Sports Foundation and Director of Amateur Sports for New York City Sports Commission. The First Lady presents the Flo Hyman Award to Mary Lou Retton, Gymnast.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a White House Collection of Arts and Crafts book photo shoot in the Blue Room of the White House with photographer Nancy Ellison.
