Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0985-F (Segment 5) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1995, through December 31, 1995. The photographs processed in this segment were created on January 16, 1995, through January 18, 1995. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Photographs from January 16, 1995, are as follows:

President Clinton disembarks Marine One at Andrews Air Force Base and crosses the tarmac to board Air Force One. The President is traveling to Denver, Colorado.

President Clinton disembarks Air Force One at Denver's Stapleton International Airport. He is accompanied by Secretary Federico Pena, Representative Pat Schroeder, and Representative Ben Nighthorse Campbell. President Clinton greets members of Dave Carpenter's family, drivers, and airport personnel in Denver.

President Clinton participates in a meeting regarding natural gas held at Combs Aviation in Denver at Stapleton International Airport. Following the meeting, President Clinton talks with Leon Panetta, Bruce Lindsey, Stephen Goodin, Grace Garcia, Marsha Scott, and Mack McLarty.

President Clinton and Governor Roy Romer address a reception at the Governor's Mansion in Denver. President Clinton greets guests and friends.

President Clinton greets people at Denver's Stapleton International Airport prior to departing for Los Angeles, California. The President holds up a baby, greets Miss Rodeo America, and Combs Aviation employees. President Clinton talks with Leon Panetta, Secretary Federico Pena, and John Emerson aboard Air Force One.

President Clinton addresses a Martin Luther King Day event at The Community Building Office in South Central, Los Angeles. Event participants include Representative Maxine Waters, Mayor Richard Riordan, Rosa Parks, Cicely Tyson, and others. President Clinton greets Rosa Parks and others at the event.

President Clinton addresses a briefing with opinion leaders at the Sheraton Miramar Hotel in Santa Monica, California. The President greets supporters at a reception including Barbra Streisand.

President Clinton greets drivers and volunteers at the Sheraton Miramar Hotel in Santa Monica.

Photographs from January 17, 1995, are as follows:

President Clinton meets with Black entertainers regarding leadership for economic infusion into the diverse communities of Los Angeles. The President greets Cicely Tyson, Quincy Jones, Denzel Washington, and others at the Sheraton Miramar Hotel in Santa Monica. President Clinton meets with Rosa Parks at the Sheraton Miramar Hotel.

Photographs from January 17, 1995, Continued:

President Clinton greets people at Los Angeles International Airport. The President talks to Mort Engleberg on the tarmac. President Clinton boards Air Force One for departure to Sacramento, California. President Clinton confers with Bruce Lindsey and others on Air Force One.

President Clinton arrives at McClellan Air Force Base in Sacramento. The President talks to Leon Panetta on the tarmac.

President Clinton visits neighborhoods in Roseville, California damaged by flooding. The President views the damage and visits with families in the recovery stage following the disaster. President Clinton participates in a community discussion with residents. The President is accompanied by James Lee Witt and Representative Vic Fazio. President Clinton greets people along the motorcade route. The President stops at Archway Frostie restaurant for a drink.

President Clinton addresses an event to mark the anniversary of the California Northridge Earthquake on the campus of California State University - Northridge. Event participants include Dr. Blenda Wilson, Mayor Richard Riordan, Secretary Federico Pena, Secretary Henry Cisneros, James Lee Witt, and others. President Clinton greets guests and officials at the event including Lt. Governor Gray Davis. President Clinton and Bruce Lindsey talk with Dave Carpenter and U.S. Secret Service agents.

President Clinton visits Fire Station #88 in Northridge. The President participates in a discussion with the Swift Water Rescue Operation personnel. President Clinton looks at water rescue equipment at the station.

President Clinton greets people at McClellan Air Force Base prior to departing California for Andrews Air Force Base. During the flight, President Clinton talks on the telephone with Prime Minister Tomiichi Murayama of Japan. Will Itoh, Bruce Lindsey, and Mike McCurry are present for the telephone call. President Clinton jokes with Leon Panetta, Mike McCurry, Marsha Scott, John Emerson, Andrew Friendly, and Secretary Federico Pena in the conference room aboard Air Force One.

Photographs from January 18, 1995, are as follows:

President Clinton walks from the East Wing of the White House to the Treasury Department with Mike McCurry and George Stephanopoulos. The President is met by Secretary Robert Rubin, Mack McLarty, Mickey Kantor, and others. The President makes remarks in the Cash Room at the Department of Treasury.

Photographs from January 18, 1995, Continued:

Prior to the President's speech, he confers with Bowman Cutter, Laura Tyson, Anthony Blinken, Secretary Rubin, Mickey Kantor, George Stephanopoulos, and Mike McCurry. President Clinton returns to the White House with Mack McLarty.

President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Senator Bob Kerry. Pat Griffin is present at the meeting. Prior to the meeting, the President confers with Steve Ricchetti, Leon Panetta, George Stephanopoulos, and Pat Griffin. Mike McCurry greets Senator Kerry in the Outer Oval Office.

President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Vice President Albert Gore, Laura Tyson, Alice Rivlin, Leon Panetta, and Mack McLarty. Secretary Robert Rubin is present with the principals in the Outer Oval Office.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton talks in the South Portico of the White House with Dr. Susan Blumenthal, Health and Human Services, and Anne Trontell, Health and Human Services, preparing to depart for New York. New York.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton talks alone with John Kluge, Chairman of Metro Media Company, at the Waldorf Astoria Hotel in New York. The First Lady talks with Ambassador Madeleine Albright in her suite at the Waldorf Astoria.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton tapes a message for the United Cerebral Palsy Telethon at the Waldorf Astoria Hotel. A small girl sits with the First Lady during the taping.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in an informal discussion with supporters in her suite at the Waldorf Astoria.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attends a United Cerebral Palsy dinner at the Waldorf Astoria Hotel. Dinner participants include John Stafford, Chairman, President and CEO of American Home Products Corporation, John Kluge, Barbara Walters, Frank Benneck, Jr., President and CEO of the Hearst Corporation, Walter Shipley, Chairman and CEO of Chemical Banking Corporation, Katherine Graham, Chairman of the Executive Committee of the Washington Post. The First Lady receives a Humanitarian Award from Katherine Graham. System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level.

While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
