Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0985-F (Segment 7) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1995, through December 31, 1995. The photographs processed in this segment were created on January 20, 1995; January 24, 1995, through January 27, 1995.

The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Photographs from January 20, 1995, are as follows:

President Clinton meets for State of the Union address preparation with Stan Greenburg and others in the Oval Office.

Photographs from January 24, 1995, are as follows:

President Clinton talks on the telephone in the Outer Oval Office near Betty Currie sitting at her desk. Stephen Goodin writes notes during the President's telephone call.

Views of a vacant Oval Office photographed in black & white.

Bruce Reed, Don Baer, and George Stephanopoulos work on the President's State of the Union address in the Family Theatre. Vice President Albert Gore talks with George Stephanopoulos and Gene Sperling during the speech preparation. Mike McCurry and others are present at the Family Theatre.

President Clinton reviews his State of the Union speech in the Diplomatic Reception Room with George Stephanopoulos and Don Baer. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton depart the White House for the U.S. Capitol. The Clintons sit alone in the Presidential Limousine at the U.S. Capitol while the President reads his speech. The Clintons arrive at the Capitol and are met by George White, Architect of the Capitol, Bill Livingood, House Sergeant-At-Arms, Howard Green, Senate Sergeant-At-Arms. President Clinton talks with members of Congress including Representative Vic Fazio, Senator John Breaux, Senator Barbara Mikulski, Senator Jay Rockefeller, Senator Alfonse D'Amato, Representative Richard Gephardt, and others. President Clinton delivers his State of the Union Address in the House Chamber of the U.S. Capitol. Vice President Albert Gore and Representative Newt Gingrich, Speaker of the House, are seated behind the President. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton and Tipper Gore are seated in the Gallery with guests mentioned in the President's address.

Following the address, the President greets Senator Chris Dodd, Representative Kweisi Mfume, and others. President Clinton greets guests including members of AmeriCorps.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton talk with staff and friends in the Yellow Oval Room of the White House after the President's State of the Union address. Present at the reception are Chelsea Clinton, Tommy Caplan, Capricia Marshall, Kelly Craighead, Bruce Lindsey, Mike McCurry, Mark Gearan, Erskine Bowles, George Stephanopoulos, Gene Sperling, Harold Ickes, Don Baer, and Mack McLarty.

Photographs from January 25, 1995, are as follows:

President Clinton jogs on the White House Jogging Track on the South Grounds.

AmeriCorps representatives visit the Oval Office. Betty Currie greets the group.

A Puerto Rico policy group meets in Roosevelt Room. Meeting participants include Hector Luis Acevedo, Hector Rivera Cruz, Celeste Benitez, Jeffrey Farrow, Richard Feinberg, Marcia Hale, and others.

Alice Rivlin greets departing Office of Management and Budget (OMB) staff members at OMB.

Personnel place Marine One landing disks on the South Lawn for the arrival of Marine One. President Clinton departs the South Portico entrance and crosses the South Lawn to depart on Marine One. The President is traveling to Allentown, Pennsylvania. President Clinton disembarks Marine One at Andrews Air Force Base. During the flight to Pennsylvania, the President meets individually with Secretary Robert Reich, Representative Tim Holden, and Phil Caplan. President Clinton talks with Bruce Lindsey, Harold Ickes, and others aboard Air Force One.

President Clinton arrives at Lehigh Valley International Airport in Allentown, Pennsylvania. President Clinton greets letter writers and others after arriving. The President greets children waving flags along the motorcade route to Kutztown.

President Clinton visits the Country Junction General Store in Lehigh, Pennsylvania. The President greets people outside the store on the street.

President Clinton visits The Charcoal Restaurant in Allentown and greets people. President Clinton talks on the telephone inside the restaurant.

Views of people holding up a sign that reads "Pres. Clinton, Middle Class American Talk to Me!" in Allentown. President Clinton greets a large contingent of people outside the Bieber Bus Terminal in Allentown. The Presidential Limousine is in the background during the greeting on the street.

President Clinton arrives at Kutztown University in Pennsylvania. President Clinton works on his speech prior to addressing students and others at the university with Harold Ickes and Phil Caplan. The President participates in a roundtable discussion and delivers remarks to the university.

The backdrop scroll during the President's speech reads, "For the Middle-Class a Bill of Rights." Following the speech the President participates in satellite interviews. President Clinton greets volunteers and drivers at the university.

President Clinton departs Allentown after visiting Kutztown. Barbara Kinney and Phil Caplan pose for individual photos on the tarmac at Andrews Air Force Base.

They walk together back to the West Wing for their interview in the Oval Office. President Clinton greets NBC staff and news personalities including Tim Russert and Brian Williams. Prior to the interview, the President participates in a briefing in the Map Room with Mike McCurry, George Stephanopoulos, Sandy Berger, Mark Gearan, Leon Panetta, and others.

Tony Lake addresses a promotion and pinning ceremony for Brigadier General Donald Kerrick, National Security Council (NSC) in the Roosevelt Room. President Clinton drops by the ceremony and greets General Kerrick and other military personnel and National Security Council staff. General Gordon Sullivan is among the guests.

President Clinton participates in a telephone call to USA Today newspaper. Ginny Terzano, Rahm Emanuel, Carol Rasco, and Bruce Reed are present in the Oval Office. Includes good shot of the President at the Resolute desk.

President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Mark Allen and Carl Kirkland.

Photographs from January 27, 1995, are as follows:

President Clinton walks up the South Lawn sidewalk with fellow joggers after their run. President Clinton poses for photos with the group in the Oval Office. Participants include Tim Finchem, PGA, Bob Lyford, John Lipphardt, Mayor of Wheeling, West Virginia, Paul Helmke, Mayor of Ft. Wayne, Indian, Tom Murphy, Mayor of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, Richard Leftwich, and others.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level.

While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
