#### **Extent**

Approximately 2,018 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

#### **Access**

#### **Scope and Content**

FOIA 2016-0985-F (Segment 8) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1995, through December 31, 1995. The photographs processed in this segment were created on January 26, 1995, through January 30, 1995. Photograph contact sheets from January 28, 1995, were previously processed in case 2022-0202-F. The finding aid inventory will reflect the previously processed photo contact sheets.

The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

**Photographs from January 26, 1995, are as follows:**

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visits the Kimball Senior Center in National City, California. The First Lady is met by Mayor George Waters and Victoria Waters. The First Lady participates in a panel discussion with Dr. Susan Blumenthal, Helen Smits, Maggie Helton, and Mary Trujillo. The discussion focuses on Mammography, Breast Cancer, and women's health issues.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at Eleanor Roosevelt College in San Diego. The First Lady greets staff volunteers and drops by a reception. The First Lady greets Roosevelt family members. The First Lady addresses a dedication ceremony for Eleanor Roosevelt College. Dais participants include Ann Craig, Provost, James Lyon, Provost Emeritus, Doris Kearns Goodwin, Biographer, David B. Roosevelt, Richard Atkinson, Chancellor, and Daniel Shaughnessy, President, United Nations Association of San Diego. The First Lady participates in an interview with Jonna Palmer and Marianne Vigil, newspaper editors of "The Guardian" school newspaper.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets California Highway Patrol personnel and others at Miramar Marine Corps Air Station in San Diego. The First Lady departs San Diego and travels to Palm Springs, California.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Walter Annenberg and Leonore Annenberg at their residence in Palm Springs. The First Lady greets Barbara Sinatra, Frank Sinatra, former President Gerald Ford, former First Lady Betty Ford, and others. Maggie Williams and Melanne Verveer are present at the Annenberg residence.

**Photographs from January 27, 1995, are as follows:**

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visits the Betty Ford Clinic in Palm Springs. The First Lady is accompanied by former First Lady Betty Ford. The First Lady tours the clinic and greets staff, children, and others.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Walter and Leonore Annenberg and others at their residence. Maggie William and Melanne Verveer are present at the meeting. The First Lady greets Annenberg residence staff prior to departing the residence.

The White House Press Pool covers the meeting. Prior to meeting, the President confers with Rahm Emanuel and George Stephanopoulos. President Clinton talks alone with Leon Panetta.

President Clinton confers in the Oval Office with Leon Panetta, Steve Ricchetti, Marcia Hale, and Carol Rasco. President Clinton meets with a Louisiana delegation in the Oval Office with Senator Bennett Johnston, Senator John Breaux, Representative William Jefferson, Mayor Marc Morial, Leon Panetta, Marcia Hale, and Steve Ricchetti.

National Security Adviser Tony Lake greets a departing National Security Council staff member in the West Wing of the White House.

President Clinton greets Jerry Jeff Walker and his guests in the Oval Office.

President Clinton talks alone in the Oval Office with Lawton Jordan.

President Clinton greets Governors' Chief of Staff following his Radio Address in the Oval Office. President Clinton signs a photograph for departing staff member David Leavy. The President talks with Jonathan Prince.

President Clinton meets with Marcia Hale in the Oval Office.

President Clinton participates in a scheduling meeting in the Cabinet Room with Billy Webster, Erskine Bowles, Anne Walley, Nancy Hernreich, and others.

**System of Arrangement**
