Approximately 2,236 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0985-F (Segment 9) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1995 through December 31, 1995.

The photographs processed in this segment were created on January 30, 1995 through February 1, 1995. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Select images responsive to this segment were previously processed in FOIA case numbers 2018-0726-F and 2019-0582-F.

Photographs from January 30, 1995 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a live satellite feed to the National Association of Black Journalists in Room 459 of the Old Executive Office Building. Following the remarks the President confers with Alexis Herman, George Stephanopoulos, and Leon Panetta.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a National Governor's Association meeting in the East Room of the White House.

President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at the Omni Shoreham Hotel in Washington, DC. Stephen Goodin, Brian McPartlin, and Dave Carpenter are present. The President speaks with McPartlin and Thomas "Mack" McLarty in a hallway. The President addresses the Democratic Governors' Association dinner. Following the event the President converses with Bruce Lindsey, Kevin O'Keefe, and Marcia Hall outside of the White House. Stephen Goodin is photographed speaking on the telephone. Also photographed is Glen Maes.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton speaks with Susan Bayh at The Mansion on O Street in Washington, DC.

Miscellaneous photographs include views of the South Lawn of the White House.

Photographs from January 31, 1995 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton is photographed on the South Lawn following his morning jog. Also photographed includes Luther Robinson, Robert Randolph, John Grater, and Governor Anthony Knowles.

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with staff in the Oval Office of the White House prior to his meeting with Congressional leadership regarding the Mexican economy. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Secretary of the Treasury Robert Rubin, Michael McCurry, Leon Panetta, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, and George Stephanopoulos.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with members of Congress in the Cabinet Room of the White House regarding the Mexican economy and the value of the Peso. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Senator Robert Dole, Representative New Gingrich, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Secretary of the Treasury Robert Rubin, Laura Tyson, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Bowman Cutter, Leon Panetta, Representative Richard Gephardt, and Larry Summers, among others. Following the meeting the President converses with McLarty, Rubin and Dole in the Oval Office. Later the President also converses with Vice President Gore, Panetta, Stephanopoulos, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, and Michael McCurry.

President William Jefferson Clinton signs Michael McCurry's commission. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Leon Panetta, and George Stephanopoulos.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Map Room of the White House with Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Bowman Cutter, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Leon Panetta, and Pat Griffin prior to a meeting with congressional representatives regarding the Mexican economy.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with guests in the Oval Office of the White House, including Hispanic educators.

President William Jefferson Clinton visits the White House kitchen staff mess. William Webster presides as chef for the day. The President greets mess personnel and staff eating in the mess. Photographed include Debi Schiff, Heather Beckel, Wendy Smith, William Galston, Patti Solis, and Thomas Ross. Later the President greets Jeff Tuchman in the West Wing.

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses the National Governors' Association meeting at the J.W. Marriott hotel in Washington, DC. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Governor Howard Dean, and Governor Tommy Thompson. The President greets hotel personnel upon arriving. Also photographed is Alan Stone, Ginny Terzano, and Marcia Hale prior to the President leaving the White House for the event.

President William Jefferson Clinton walks along the Colonnade of the White House to the South Portico prior to departing for Boston, Massachusetts. The President greets Larry Woodard. Marine One lifts off from the South Lawn Landing Zone en route Andrews Air Force Base and leading to departure via Air Force One. Also photographed includes Senator John Kerry, Senator Ted Kennedy, Theresa Heinz, Vicki Kennedy, Harold Ickes, Nancy Soderberg, and Jack Farrell (The Boston Globe), among others. The President arrives at Boston Logan International Airport.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with the Mayor's Youth Council at the Parkman House in Boston, Massachusetts. Present includes Mayor Thomas Menino and Eugenia Kiu, among others. The President is presented with a Red Sox jacket and participates in a photograph opportunity with members of the Mayor's Youth Council.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in radio interviews by telephone at the Park Plaza Hotel in Boston, Massachusetts. Present includes Bruce Lindsey, Ginny Terzano, Mark Gearan, Harold Ickes, and Stephen Goodin.

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with staff & guests prior to and during departure from Boston, Massachusetts to Andrews Air Force Base. Present include Ted Kennedy, Vicki Kennedy, Senator John Kerry, Theresa Heinz, Senator Chris Dodd, Don Fowler, Susan Brophy, Nancy Soderberg, Wendy Smith, and Stephen Goodin.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Doug Picha in the West Wing.

Photographs from February 1, 1995 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton drops by a meeting with law enforcement officials at the White House.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Oval Office of the White House with President Isaias Afwerki of Eritrea. Present at the meeting includes Secretary of State Warren Christopher and Tony Lake. Later the President speaks on the telephone in the Oval Office of the White House with President Hosni Mubarak of Egypt. Present includes Leon Panetta, Martin Indyk, and Colonel Jim Reed.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets the Solheim Cup ladies professional golfing association winners in the Oval Office of the White House. Present includes JoAnne Carner, Donna Andrews,

Brandie Burton, Beth Daniel, Tammie Green, Betsy King, Meg Mallon, Dottie Mochrie, Kelly Robbins, Patty Sheehan, and Sherri Steinhauer.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Democratic members of the appropriations committee in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Representative Steny Hoyer, Representative Charles Wilson, Representative Martin Olav Sabo, Representative Louis Stokes, Representative Sidney Yates, Representative David Obey, Representative Victor Fazio, George Stephanopoulos, Alice Rivlin, Michael McCurry, Leon Panetta, and Susan Brophy, among others. Later the President converses with Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Tony Lake, and Don Steinberg in the Oval Office.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with staff prior to departing for the Pentagon. Present are Tony Lake, Leon Panetta, and George Stephanopoulos. The President pets Socks the cat on the South Grounds of the White House as he departs en route the Pentagon. At the Pentagon the President is greeted by General John Shalikashvili, Secretary of Defense William Perry, and John Deutch. The President meets with senior military commanders at the Pentagon including the Joint Chiefs of Staff. Present include General Shalikashvili, General Williams Owens, General Ronald Fogelman, General Carl Mundy, General Gordon Sullivan, Admiral Robert Kramek, Leon Panetta, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, and Deutch, among others. The President also greets employees at the Pentagon. The President returns to the White House with Panetta. Also shown is the President working alone at his desk prior to leaving for the Pentagon.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets animators of the Walt Disney company and members of the United States international math team in the West Wing of the White House.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at the National Museum of Women in the Arts in Washington, DC. Photographed includes James Johnson (Federal National Mortgage Association) Franklin Raines (Fannie Mae), and Wilhelmina Holladay.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
